**UPDATE – Campus Upgrade Appeal**

Thank you to all those who have already made a pledge and/or a contribution to the Appeal. Your generosity is sincerely appreciated.

Below is the current status as of the week ending October 7, 2018. It includes cash collected from Parishioners only and does not include approximately \$50,000 from the past Vision of Faith Campaign that will also be available once the Rectory renovation commences:

## St. Thomas More Parish CAMPUS UPDATE APPEAL

This announcement will provide detailed information about the upcoming St. Thomas More Campus Upgrades and the fund raising Appeal. Please read it carefully.

While the campus of St. Thomas More Parish has not been neglected since it was built almost 50 years ago, there are several areas that need some upgrading. There will be two phases to the upgrades. The first phase will incorporate renovation of the Rectory as well as security updates in the Religious Education Center and the Church. The second phase will include limited renovations to the Religious Education Center, a few updates in the Church and work on the parking lot and exterior security.

Phase 1 will start with the Rectory renovation which will include the following:

- ✓ New windows and interior and exterior doors,
- ✓ New drywall on first floor ceilings and wherever else it's required,
- ✓ New wood and laminate flooring,
- ✓ A completely new kitchen, including cabinets and appliances,
- ✓ New fixtures, accessories, shower enclosures and new tile grout in bathrooms,
- ✓ Two new heat pumps,
- ✓ Replacement of the electric heat registers which will back up the heat pumps in severe weather,
- ✓ A new security system,
- ✓ New light fixtures where required,
- ✓ New interior and exterior paint,
- ✓ New vinyl siding,
- ✓ A new roof, including gutters and downspouts,
- ✓ New garage doors and siding on the garage.

In the remainder of Phase 1 we will install a complete security system in the Religious education center, including electric locks on the main entrance door of the facility. Security cameras and monitors will be incorporated into this system. Additionally, the security and fire alarm system in the Church will be reviewed and receive attention as needed.

The second phase of the upgrades will start next year and bridge into 2020. This phase will commence in the Religious Education Center with the installation of a new roof, replacement of the HVAC systems and repair or replacement of windows and exterior doors. It will also include cleaning or replacing pew cushions and replacing carpeting where required in the Church. We will complete Phase 2 by making repairs to the parking lot and then re-seal and re-line it. Finally, improvement of exterior lighting throughout the campus and installation of exterior security cameras and monitors in the parking areas will be accomplished as well.

The total Budget for all of this work is **\$500,000**. The good news, however, is that we already have **\$100,000** cash on hand for these projects. The sources of these funds are from the 2011 **Heritage of Faith - Vision of Hope Campaign** and an early contribution made by an anonymous Parishioner specifically for the Appeal. **The net amount that we still need to raise is \$400,000**. Please note that all collected funds will be maintained in St. Thomas More's "Campus Upgrade" Account which will be solely dedicated to the St. Thomas More Campus Upgrades.

From a timing perspective we anticipate the following:

- ✓ Complete the Rectory renovations before the Archbishop's visit on May 19, 2019.
- ✓ Pledges must be received by October 15, 2018. Pledges may be paid in up to 4 installments as follows:
  - First installment of 25% of Total Pledge is due by **November 1, 2018**
  - Second installment of 25% of Total Pledge is due by **May 1, 2019**
  - Third installment of 25% of Total Pledge is due by **November 1, 2019**
  - Fourth installment of 25% of Total Pledge is due by **November 1, 2020**
- ✓ Letters containing an Appeal Pledge form will be sent to all regular contributors the week of September 10<sup>th</sup>.
- ✓ On the weekend of September 15<sup>th</sup> pledge forms will be found in the pews.
- ✓ During the week of September 22<sup>nd</sup> we will place a large chart in the Narthex to provide an on-going tracking our fund raising progress. This will also be reported in the weekly Sunday Bulletins.

We ask that you pray for the success of the Appeal and hope that you will be as generous as you can to support it. God bless you!
