

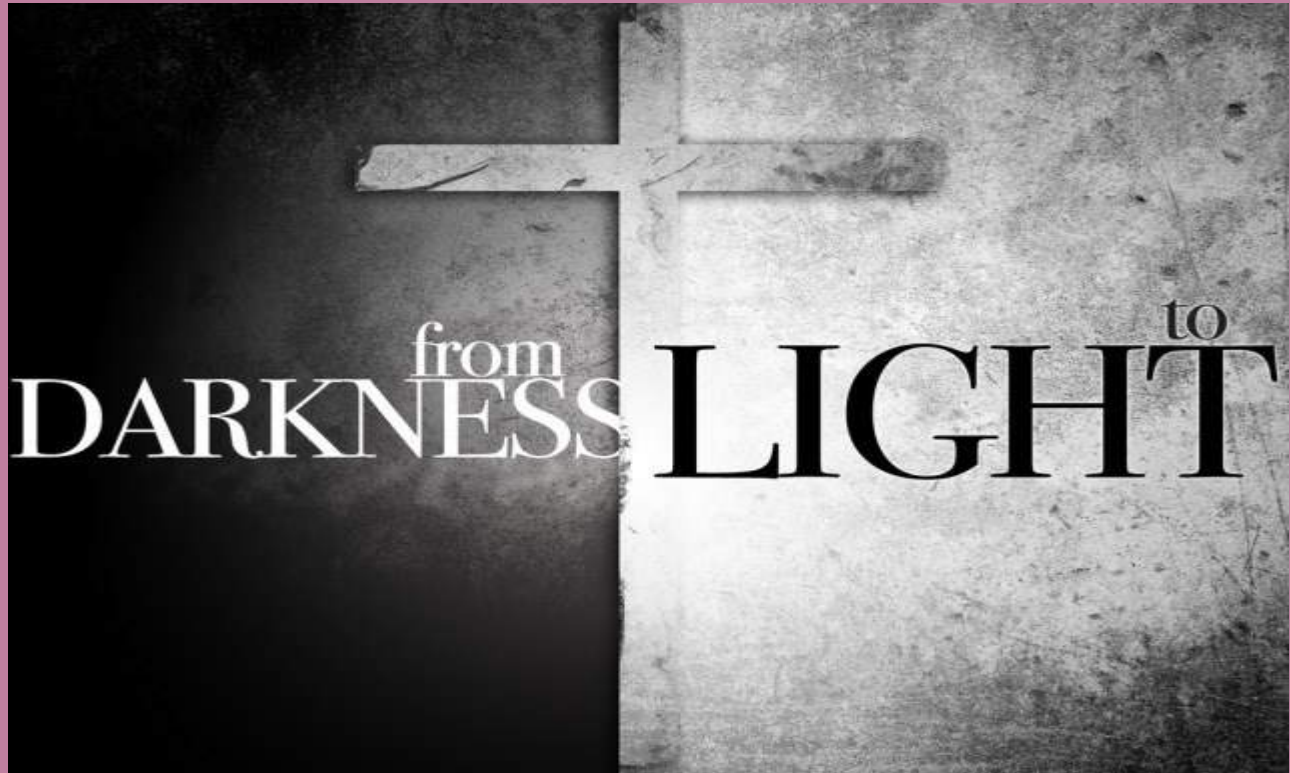

From the Desk of Fr. Joe...

How is Your Lent Going?

Today starts the fourth week in the Season of Lent. Is it getting old? Are you tired of making sacrifices? Are you weary from fasting? Have you prayed more than you normally do? How's this Lent going for you?

I think it is easy to start with great fervor, but as it always does, life gets in the way. I had great aspirations and expectations for this Lent and, before long, I was struggling to do the things I wanted to do. Do you feel the same way?

It's not too late start again if you have gone off track. There is still plenty of Lent left to do the things we tried to do at the beginning. Now if you have not gone off track, that is a blessing. I encourage you to stay the course.

For the rest of us, it's time to recommit to our Lenten promises. Don't see your slip-ups as a failure and give up. Start all over again. Begin anew! That, in a sense, is what our Faith is all about. New beginnings. If you haven't tried one of our Lenten small group opportunities, you still can. See the bulletin for the times.

If you haven't taken advantage of the Sacrament of Reconciliation yet, there are plenty of opportunities left. Each Tuesday night, confessions are heard during the Stations of the Cross. We start about 7:15. In addition to that, we have our normally scheduled confessions on Saturday morning and Saturday afternoon. The morning session begins at 7:30AM and the afternoon session at 3:30PM. You are also welcome to make an appointment to go to confession outside of those times.

By the time you read this letter, my intention is to have the statues in church veiled. This is customary at this point in Lent. It's another way for us to enter into the spirituality of the Lenten season. We can take for granted these holy images that represent aspects of our salvation. When they are visually taken away, it reminds us of all that Christ has won for us through his Passion, Death and Resurrection.

As we journey toward Holy Week, let us recommit to our Lenten promises. May the rest of the Lenten Season be a blessed one for all of us!

Parish News



Next weekend we will celebrate the 5th Sunday Of Lent. In the Gospel reading from John, we hear the end of Jesus' public ministry as he begins to turn his attention to the Passion. Jesus tells his disciples that he will be "glorified" through the cross. In our opening hymn **Forty Days And Forty Nights #130** we are reminded that our Lenten journey is coming to an end as we approach Holy Week. We sing of both Jesus' coming Passion as we are "fasting with unceasing prayer; strong with you to suffer pain" and pray for the grace to share in the Resurrection - "Keep, o keep us, Savior dear; ever constant by your side; that with You we may appear; at the eternal Eastertide."

As the gifts are prepared we will sing the words of Psalm 90 **In Every Age #474**. In this Psalm we profess our belief that God is ever present with us as we journey through life - "In every age you have been our refuge; in every age you have been our hope." We also pray for the grace to remain faithful in the struggles of life so as to share in the Resurrection - "Teach us to embrace every joy and pain; to sleep peacefully; and to rise up strong."

As we come forward to receive Communion we will sing **Hosea #663**. Again, we are called by God to "come back to me with all your heart; don't let fear keep us apart." As we receive our Blessed Lord we pray in the refrain - "Long have I waited for your coming home to me and living deeply our new life."

In our recessional hymn **Lord Who Throughout These 40 Days #139** we are again reminded to begin turning our attention to Holy Week as Lent is drawing to a close. We pray to our Lord - "abide with us that when this life of suffering is past; An Easter of unending joy we may attain at last!"

Former NBA Referee, Deacon Steve Javie, will be with us to share his story of faith.

Deacon Steve Javie was born and raised in the Philadelphia area. He attended LaSalle High School in Philadelphia and graduated in 1972. He went on to attend Temple University in Philadelphia playing baseball for 4 years and graduated with a business degree in 1976.

After a brief stint in the minor leagues, Steve's focus turned to officiating and was hired to referee in the CBA, the minor league for the NBA. After spending 5 years in the minor leagues Steve was hired by the NBA in 1986 where he officiated for 25 years. During his career, Steve officiated over 1,400 regular season games, 240 playoff games, 23 Finals games and 2 All Star games.

After his career in the NBA, Steve, wanting to serve the Catholic Church, felt a calling to become a Deacon. In 2012 he attended St. Charles Seminary in Philadelphia where he would be in formation for the next 7 years.

In 2019 Steve was ordained a Deacon in the Catholic Church by Philadelphia Archbishop, Charles Chaput. He and his wife Maryellen currently reside in Newtown and he is assigned to St. Andrew Parish in Newtown PA.
