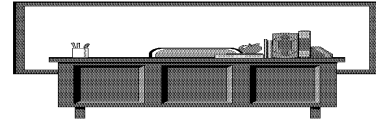

**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK**

As we journey through these autumn Sundays, we will hear a string of intriguing parables from St. Matthew's Gospel. Today Our Lord seems to be asking us: Do you understand my goodness and generosity? Do you even think about things as I do?

How might we see things differently? Do you realize that the "Golden Arches" of McDonald's and the logo for Coke are more recognized throughout the world than the Cross?

Do people see that while they will leave a 20% tip for a meal, many give less than 2% of their income to church and charity? The Progressive Insurance Company conducted a survey that found that 45% of married Americans listed their car as more important to them than their children.

We must learn to see the world with different eyes - with eyes that love God. This is Our Lord's teaching in today's readings.

We tend to think in terms of scorecards when applying justice and even mercy to God. We think that if our goodness outweighs our badness, we'll go to heaven.


Our readings, though, invite us to come to a better understanding of God's goodness and generosity. If God looks to the current situation of our hearts, what will He see? Hopefully He will find that we have been consciously receptive and attentive to His love.

And so we ask the Holy Spirit to enlighten us, strengthen us and guide us to apply true wisdom and charity in all that we say and do.
