Baptisms: Arrangements for Baptism can be made at the Parish Office prior to or after the baby's birth. A Pre-Jordan session is required of new parents. Please call the Religious Education Office for these arrangements. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics. A certificate of eligibility is required.

Marriage: Arrangements must be made at least 6 months in advance with the Pastor in order to provide for all Archdiocesan requirements.

Sacrament of the Sick: All are encouraged to receive this Sacrament prior to hospitalization for surgery or if suffering from a serious sickness. Please call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

REFLECTIONS FROM THE DESK OF FR. GREGORY J. HICKEY

“Continuation of a Call to Integrity” Part II

Are you being called to be a Sponsor at Baptism or Confirmation?

As a Godparent for Baptism or a Sponsor for Confirmation, you do have specific functions. The Church describes them as the following:

1. To support the parents in communicating and nurturing the faith of the child
2. To support the candidate in their faith development
3. To accompany the candidate, if possible to special liturgies
4. To help the child or the candidate live as a follower of Jesus

Some of the following suggestions will not be possible if you live away from the area but be creative and think of ways to be in contact with the candidate.

1. Arrange opportunities to spend time with the parents of the child or the candidate himself/herself, if age appropriate, and to enjoy being together. Some of these can relate directly to the Baptism.
2. Discuss with the parents of the child or candidate the efforts, progress and problems experienced in preparing for the reception of Baptism or Confirmation. Help them to review the Basic Faith concepts and see if there are any questions or concerns.
3. Offer suggestions and encouragement, as they are needed.
4. Arrange some time to pray together or to read a passage from Scripture together. If you live close by, make plans to participate in the Eucharist (Mass) together.
5. Keep in contact with the parents of the child or your candidate either in person or on the telephone.

Take time for yourself. Put aside some time for thinking and praying. Sponsors can begin to see how they can improve the quality of their role. There are many ways to go about this. One could just spend time alone, quietly reflecting; take up a journal and attempt writing one's reflections; or talk over things with a friend. You might ask yourself:

1. Can I share my faith unashamedly?
2. Do I live close enough to really get to know my Godchild/Candidate?
3. Am I an active member of my local parish?
4. What has being asked to be a Godparent or Sponsor taught me about my faith this week?
5. What can I do to encourage the child or candidate I am sponsoring in his/her faith life?
6. What do I want to pray especially for this week?

We pray that your role as a Godparent or Sponsor will be an enriching one.

A Sponsor must meet the following requirements:

1. I believe and accept the teachings of the Roman Catholic Church.
2. I am at least 16 years of age.
3. I have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation in the Catholic Church.
4. If married, I celebrated the Sacrament of Marriage in the Catholic Church or with the approval of the Catholic Church.
5. I receive the Sacraments of Holy Eucharist and Reconciliation regularly and live a life in harmony with the faith and the role to be undertaken.
6. I understand and accept the responsibility, which I undertake as a sponsor, and I am a registered member of the parish and a practicing Catholic.
7. I am prepared to assist the parents in their Christian duty by my support, encouragement, and prayer.

The sponsor's home parish has the right to verify that he/she is qualified to be a Sponsor.
