PROPERTY TAX REBATE

To help with the rising cost of living, YOU are reminded that Pennsylvania Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program applications are now available. There are new guidelines which will permit individuals that qualify to receive a rebate between \$250 and \$650 from property taxes or rent paid last year. This application must be filed by JUNE 30, 2019. To qualify, you must be 65 years of age or older, a widow or widower 50 years of age or older, or a disabled person 18 years or older. Maximum annual incomes for homeowners(\$35,000) and for renters(\$15,000) who qualify. For more info, call United Social Services at 215-923-1900 from M-F 10AM to 4PM.
