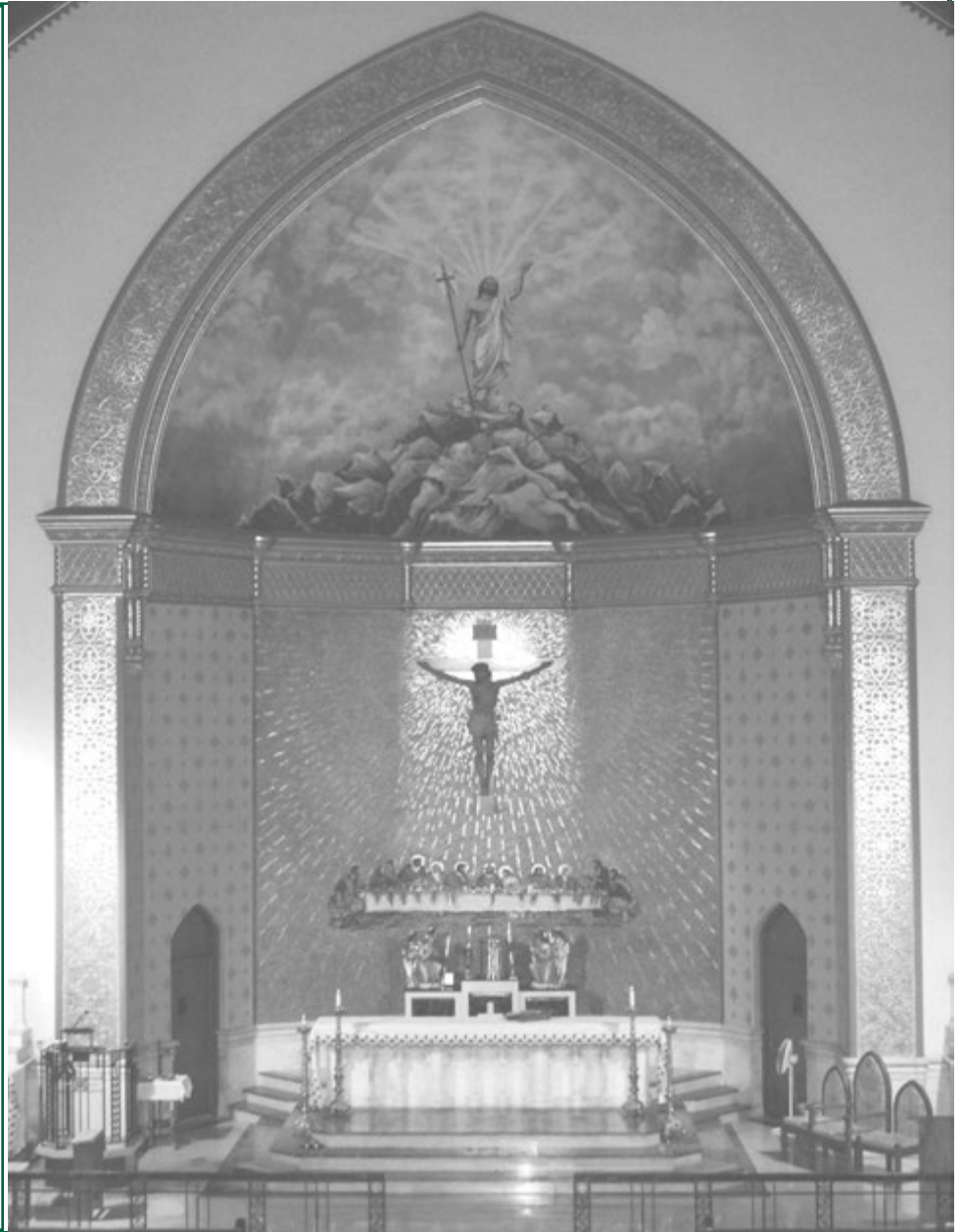

ANNUAL PUERTO RICAN MASS

The annual Puerto Rican Mass will be celebrated on Thursday, September 21, 2017 at the Cathedral Basilica of Sts. Peter and Paul. The Rosary procession will start at 6:30 pm followed by mass at 7:00 pm. The main celebrant and homilist will be Rev. Eric Cruz, pastor of Saint John Chrysostom in Bronx, NY and Representative of the Cardinal of the Archdiocese of NY for the Puerto Rican Community. The theme for this year is "Somos un Pueblos Minionero".

PROPERTY TAX REBATE PROGRAM

To help with the rising cost of living, you are reminded that Pennsylvania Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program applications are now available. There are new guidelines which will permit individuals that qualify to receive a rebate between \$250 and \$650 from property taxes or rent paid last year. Funding for this rebate program is made possible by the Pennsylvania State Lottery Fund and is a rebate that does not have to be repaid.

This application must be filed by June 30, 2017.

To qualify, you must be 65 years of age or older, a widow or widower 50 years of age or older, or a disabled person 18 years of age or older. Homeowners that have annual incomes of \$35,000 or less and renters with annual incomes of \$15,000 or less could qualify.

Only half of your annual Social Security or SSI income is counted toward the income guideline.

Important Note: Senior Citizens living in Philadelphia can also apply for the City of Philadelphia Property TAX Freeze Program.

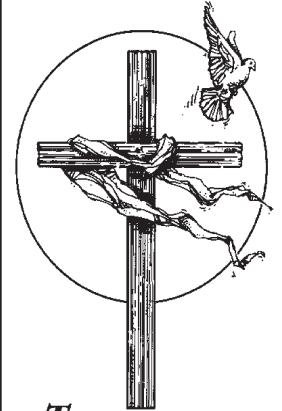
