SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Fast, Abstinence and Acts of Penance for Lent

The Bishops of the United States prescribe, as a minimal obligation, that all persons who are 14 years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and on all the Fridays of Lent, including Good Friday. All persons 18 years of age or older, up to and including their 59th birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to one full meal on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, while the other two meals on those days are to be light.

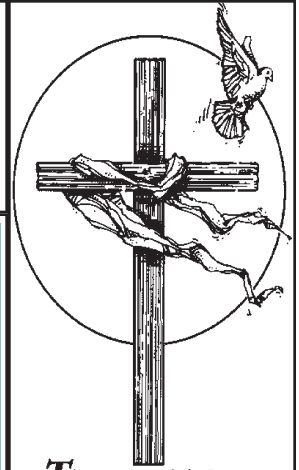
