SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

At their recent Provincial meeting on May 1st, the Bishops of PA voted to approve a recommendation that each Catholic diocese and eparchy in the Commonwealth be dedicated to the Blessed Mother in observance of the 100th Anniversary of the apparition of the Blessed Mother at Fatima.

Official dedication – 12:00 Noon Mass at St Patrick’s Cathedral in Harrisburg on Wednesday, September 27th celebrated by all the Bishops in the Commonwealth.

The second part of the dedication will be an observance in each diocese and eparchy the weekend of October 14/15th. More details will be forthcoming.


