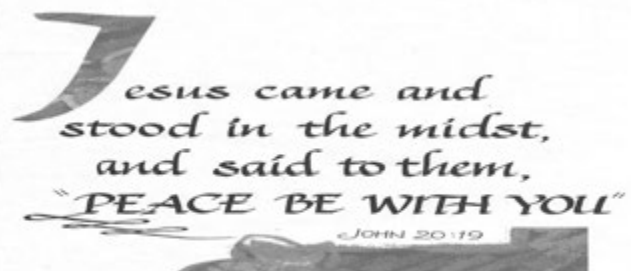

Dear Friends,

Congratulations to Father Peter DiMaria, who is celebrating the 25th anniversary of his ordination with a Mass here at Sacred Heart at 3 PM on Sunday. Father DiMaria is spiritual director at St. Meinrad Seminary in Indiana and resides in our rectory when the seminary is not in session. Due to this special event taking place in our church, the 5 PM Mass on Sunday is cancelled.

A special one hour webinar entitled “Parents, Kids and Porn: The Conversation,” sponsored by the Religious Alliance Against Pornography and the Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas and approved by Archbishop Chaput, is being offered on Tuesday, May 22 at 8:00 PM. The webinar is being offered free of charge and is directed at parents to help them initiate age-appropriate discussion with their children about the pitfalls of technology, social media, and pornography. Parents are highly encouraged to register their children as soon as possible for the 2018-2019 Year. Registration Fees for next year’s PREP are \$100 for one child and \$175 for two or more children if they are paid before June 30. After July 1, the fees increase to \$150 for one child and \$250 for two or more children. Registration forms are available for pick up after Mass in the pamphlet rack in the church narthex and during the week at the rectory.

The parish’s regular operating income and expenses for the third quarter were reviewed by the Parish Finance Council. A summary of the report can be found in today’s bulletin.

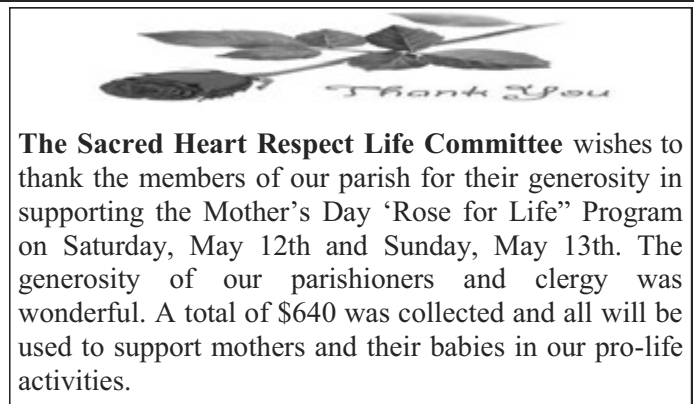
The offerings received for the Ascension Holyday came to \$1,735. The Catholic Home Missions collection was \$1,392. Thank you for your generosity.

Requests for Announced Masses (those made for a specific day and time) during the last six months of 2018 are being accepted beginning Monday, May 21. By way of reminder, the Church requires one Mass each weekend and Holyday of Obligation to be offered for the people of the parish. Announced Masses requests are filled on a first come basis. It is preferred that announced Mass intention requests be made in person at the parish office during regular business hours. Unannounced Mass intentions, those with no specific day or time requested, can be made at any time. These Masses are offered usually within a short time after the request is made. The parish reserves the right to transfer requests for unannounced Masses to a retired priest or a priest working in other than parish ministry.

The Priest Personnel Manual states that in addition to vacation and the annual retreat, a priest is entitled to one day off each week, including an overnight. *It is understood that some adjustment to the pastoral schedule may need to be made in order to accommodate the priest’s need for a day off.* In light of this, requests for an 8 AM Mass on days when I am away either for vacation, fulfilling responsibilities as National Chaplain for the First Catholic Slovak Union, or a day off (usually Thursdays) will be put on hold. The parish reserves the right to transfer a weekday Mass intention to another day if circumstances warrant. Thank you for your understanding.
