Dear Friends,

Our parish, in union with the Ancient Order of Hibernians, Notre Dame 1 Montgomery County Division, is hosting a "Blue Mass" next Sunday, October 1, for our local police officers, firefighters and emergency response personnel. The "Blue Mass" will be our regularly scheduled 5:00 PM Mass.

Also next Sunday, a blessing of pets in honor of St. Francis of Assisi will take place on the front steps of the church at 12:00 noon.

Pope Francis this Wednesday, September 27, will launch "Share the Journey," a campaign sponsored by Caritas Internationalis that aims to dispel fear and inspire communities to build relationships with people forced to leave their native lands due to violence, oppression, famine, and other hardships in search of a decent and safe life for their families. "Share the Journey" is set to run through September 2019.

In solidarity with Pope Francis, "Share the Journey" will begin in our archdiocese at the 11:00 AM Mass celebrated by Archbishop Chaput on Sunday, September 24, at Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul. This Mass is being combined with the liturgy that had already been planned in thanksgiving for the men and women religious serving in our archdiocese who are marking their jubilee anniversaries. Many consecrated religious have a deep passion for matters related to immigrants and refugees. All are welcome to attend the Mass which will include a procession of recent immigrants and refugees from local parishes and the Refugee Resettlement Program of Catholic Social Services.

The Holy Father is encouraging all to participate in a "Week of Prayer and Action" for migrants and refugees beginning at Masses during the week of October 8. For more information, please visit <http://journey.caritas.org>.

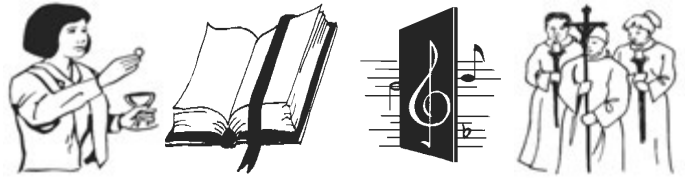

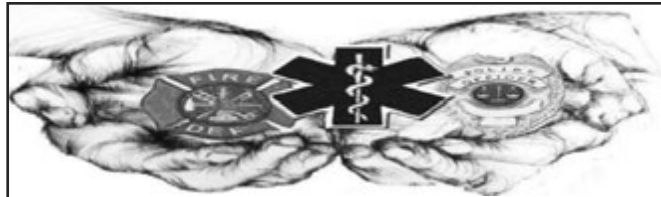

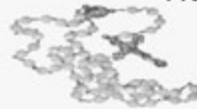
