Dear Friends,

This Monday, May 29<sup>th</sup>, we celebrate **Memorial Day** - a National Day of remembrance to honor all those men and women, who have given their lives through countless encounters, to ensure that our great nation remains the “*Home of the Free, and the Land of the Brave*”. **All are welcome to join us**

**on Monday morning at 9:00am for a Mass to honor and pray for all those who have given their lives for the sake of freedom.**

While this weekend is oftentimes the ‘official’ start of summer, and many people will gather over these days to celebrate with family and friends, we would be greatly remiss if we did not pause from the festivities of our weekend and acknowledge the true purpose and real reason for Memorial Day: **We pay tribute to the brave men and women (perhaps some were our relatives and friends) who paid the ultimate price so that we can live in peace and freedom.**

Around our nation a myriad of communities will gather to remember, pay tribute and pray for those who have laid down their lives in defense of all that our nation stands for - the principles that were first conceived in 1776 and which have been defended and honored during these past two hundred and forty one years of American history.

A most prominent element at all of our nation’s Memorial Day observances is the American flag: the ‘stars and stripes’, which represent to the world the United States of America. For more than 200 years the American flag has been the symbol of our great nation’s strength, resilience, spirit and unity.

While the American flag has seen several alterations and changes over the last 200-plus years, the colors have remained the same: Red symbolizes hardiness and valor; White symbolizes purity and innocence; and, Blue represents vigilance, perseverance and justice. The present arrangement on the flag (*13 alternating stripes of red and white*) represent the original thirteen colonies and the field of blue contains fifty stars –represent each of the states in the Union.

Because the American flag represents the United States of America, it should always be treated with the greatest respect at all times. Because the American flag represents our great nation, honorable citizens should be cognizant to always observe the following rules of protocol:

- When the flag is displayed, it should always be lighted at all times, either by sunlight or another light source.
- The flag should only be flown during inclement weather if it is designed for such circumstances.
- The flag should never be dipped to any person, nor to anything.
- The flag should only be flown upside-down as a signal of genuine distress.
- The flag should not be used for decorative purposes.
- The flag should never be used in any form of advertising.
- The flag should never be embroidered or printed on with elements other than its proper elements.
- The flag should never be impressed on cushions, napkins, boxes or any item that will be discarded after a temporary usage.
- The flag should not be used as part of a costume or athletic uniform; a flag patch may be worn on the uniform of military personnel, fire fighters, police officers, and members of patriotic organizations.
- The flag should never be written on.
- The flag should never be used as a receptacle for receiving, holding, carrying or delivering anything.
- The flag should never be allowed to touch the ground; when it is lowered, it should be received by waiting hands.
- When the American flag is flown on the same pole as another flag (*such as a state flag, community flag, scout flag, etc.*), the American flag is always flown on top.
- Flags of other countries may never be flown on the same flag pole.
- When flown beside another flag(s), the America flag may be the same size, but not smaller than other flags.

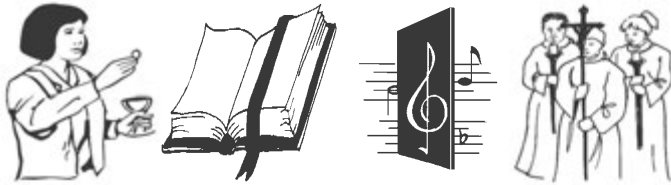


### **Memorial Day Mass**

- When flown with other flags, the American flag is always the first flag raised and the last flag lowered; except when flown with another countries flag; in this circumstance, the country flags are raised and lowered simultaneously.
- Only the President of the United States or the Governor of a state may order the flag to be flown half-staff.
- A tattered or worn flag should be destroyed in a dignified manner.

As we gather in churches and halls, in backyards and homes, on fields and parade routes this Memorial Day Weekend, may we not let this holiday pass without realizing why it exists! May the ultimate sacrifice that was paid by countless American heroes throughout the centuries help each us realize that freedom is never free; and that, if we are going to truly honor those who gave their lives for freedom's sake, we have a duty to safeguard all that they laid their lives down to defend!

**Stand Up For Life Rally...**

At the State Capitol Rotunda Harrisburg 11:00 AM, Tuesday, June 6, 2017. This Rally renews the pro-life movement in Pa. This Rally also urges the Pa. General Assembly to pass S.B.300 and S.B.3 to, respectively, defund Planned Parenthood and other abortion committers in Pa. and to extend Pa.'s ban on abortions from 24-weeks to 20-weeks gestation and ban dismemberment abortions with the same exceptions as Pa.'s Abortion Control Act. This rally will also remind our state legislators that, their actions can save and have saved thousands of women and children from abortions, and they have the support of many citizens throughout Pennsylvania. For many years, Pennsylvania led the nation in the passage of pro-life legislation. Such legislation has resulted in the reduction of the annual number of abortions committed in Pennsylvania from 65,777 in 1980 to 31,818 in 2015. However, Pennsylvania has not yet joined the many other states that have passed this life-saving pro-life legislation. Pennsylvania is still providing approximately \$6 million annually to PP and allowing 1,588 dismemberment abortions and 380 post 20-week gestation abortions to be committed each year.

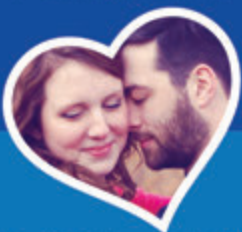
