Dear Friends,

Just about every parish in the archdiocese participates in the Missionary Cooperative Appeal each year. Father Derry Murphy, sac, Provincial Rector of the Pallottines' Mother of Divine Love Province in Ireland, is assigned to Sacred Heart parish and will be here next weekend to speak at all the Masses.

The Pallottines follow the charism of St. Vincent Pallotti (1795-1850) by promoting collaboration between the laity, diocesan priests, and consecrated religious. A quote attributed to St. Vincent Pallotti reads as follows: "My God, my mercy, you in your infinite mercy grant me in a special way to promote, establish, spread, perfect and perpetuate with a desire no less than the most living desire within your Sacred Heart."

Mother of Divine Love Province is charged with staffing parishes and institutions in Ireland, England, Rome (Basilica of San Silvestro in Capite), Argentina, Kenya, Tanzania, and the United States (Archdiocese of Detroit, Dioceses of Fort-Worth and Springfield-Cape Girardeau). Donations put in the envelopes dated July 30 and marked Mission Appeal will be sent to the Pontifical Mission Societies of the archdiocese, who in turn will distribute the funds to the Pallottines for their needs.

I have met already with our PREP teachers and they are very much enthused about the upcoming school year. I have also discovered that Sacred Heart parish has approximately 110 registered households with children between the ages of five and twelve. These families received a letter from me this past week along with a registration form for PREP. Parents are highly encouraged now to register their children. Registration fees are \$125 for the first child, \$200 for two children and \$250 for three or more children. After August 20, the fees increase to \$150 for the first child, \$250 for two children and \$300 for three or more children.

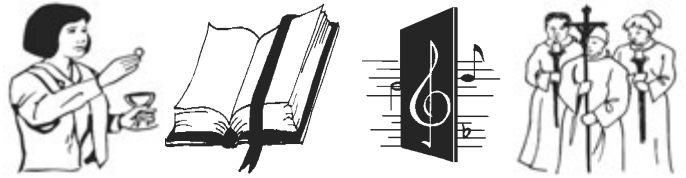

Pope Leo XIII in his encyclical "Mirae caritatis" (1902) beautifully elaborated this point and emphasized the connection between the communion of saints with the Mass.*)

In Memoriam

Our Parish offers several opportunities to remember loved ones and to commemorate special occasions through memorials in our Parish. In addition to having a Mass offered for a deceased relative or friend (*to honor a special occasion, or to give thanks to the Lord for a special favor*), you may sponsor our sanctuary lamp for their intentions, or commemorate the memory of a loved one or honor a special occasion by donating the Bread and Wine used in our Parish for a week. All are welcome to call or stop by the rectory to make these arrangements.



**Do you suffer from
Celiac Disease?**

Our parish offers a special **low-gluten** host for those who join us for Mass, either during the week or for Sunday Mass. The low-gluten hosts we offer contain **.01% gluten**. According to the magazine, *Gluten-Free Living*, experts from the Center for Celiac Research at the University of Maryland call the host, "*Perfectly safe*", stating, "*you would have to eat 270 wafers everyday to reach the danger point.*" (However, it is recommended that any Celiac suffers who wish to receive these hosts consult with their physician before usage.) Anyone who may be interested in receiving Holy Communion with a low-gluten host is asked to see Leo Brady or Father Nasta before Mass.

**IRISH PALLOTTINE FATHERS
MISSION APPEAL**

Next weekend July 22/23, Fr. Jeremiah Murphy, S.A.C. will visit the parish to speak at all Masses about the missionary work of the Irish Pallottine Father in Tanzania, Kenya and Colombia. The envelope marked for Mission CO-OP in your packet of envelopes will be to support their work of evangelization and development in those countries. Please be generous in your support of their missionary outreach.

The Pallottine Fathers were founded in Rome in 1835. Their name is derived from the family name of their founder, Saint Vincent Pallotti. He was a priest of the Diocese of Rome. He founded this community to promote the revival of faith and charity in the world by encouraging the apostolate of the laity and through the extension of the missionary work of the Church. He died in 1850 and was canonized by Pope Saint John XXIII.

Fr. Jeremiah currently is the Provincial of the Irish Pallottine Fathers. He worked for several years in Argentina before assuming his present responsibility.
