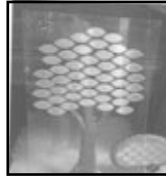
Saint Anne Guild Enrollment

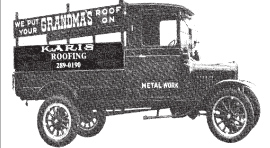
