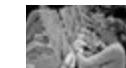

History of St. Anne's Parish Wednesday, August 11, 1880

Several hundred parishioners of St. Anne's and other parishes enjoyed themselves at the famous resort. In the evening, on the return trip, at Mays Landing, New Jersey, catastrophe overtook the excursionists and brought death to many.

The road was only a single track and, as such, has sidings to allow trains to pass each other, the first of these being at this place. But before he had been able to place it on the siding, his last car was struck by the engine of the second train. So violent was the concussion that the platform was completely shattered and the door burst open. At the same moment the cylinder of the engine was rent and through the opening the steam rushed violently into the car. Immediately there was a scene of wild confusion and the alarm soon spread to every car on both sections.

The Reverend Francis J. Quinn, Assistant at St. Anne's who accompanied the excursionists, rushed from one car to another, reassuring the people and entreating them to keep quiet. When he reached the last car, the wild scene that presented itself was truly horrifying. The poor people were actually frantic from the scalding which they were undergoing from the escaped steam. As fast as they could get away they were flying from the place. Some of them threw themselves into a stream which the train was crossing, which is known as the Great Egg Harbor River.

The tragedy resulted in the death of twenty-five of the excursionists.

On Thursday morning, August 26th, a Solemn Requiem Mass was offered for the souls of the victims. Most Reverend Archbishop Wood presided and delivered the sermon. The celebrant was Father Kieran; the deacon the Reverend Thomas Mullen; the subdeacon, the Reverend Francis Quinn.

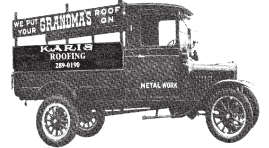
