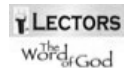

Have you ever tried Sopa de Queso from Nicaragua? Or Lablabi Soup from Iraq? Or Bean Cake from Burkina Faso?

The one thing they all have in common is they are *really cheap to make, yet nourishing*

It all started in the Allentown Diocese in 1975 when Msgr. Robert Coll along with some ecumenical partners got the idea of a very simple family meal weekly during Lent with the savings placed in a bowl to be donated to relieving hunger in the poorest counties of the world.

One quarter of the funds raised go to assist home-grown hunger— in Philadelphia’s cast it is through archdiocesan Nutritional Development Services (NDS).

That was not long after the strict rules of daily fast and abstinence from meat and meat products by Catholics on certain days were mostly abolished. This was fasting not for the sake of fasting, but fasting for a causes.

The Catholic bishops picked up on it the following year and bow it is practiced in many if not most dioceses annually. Under this plan 75 percent of the money raised goes to feeding the poor abroad and 25 percent stays in the local diocese for similar causes.

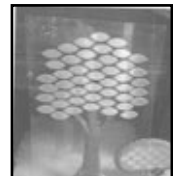

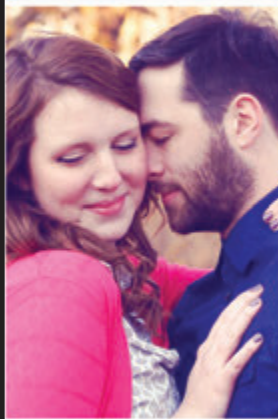

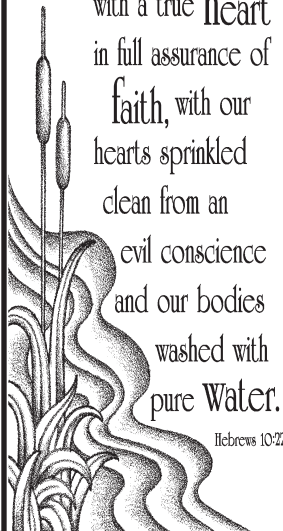
