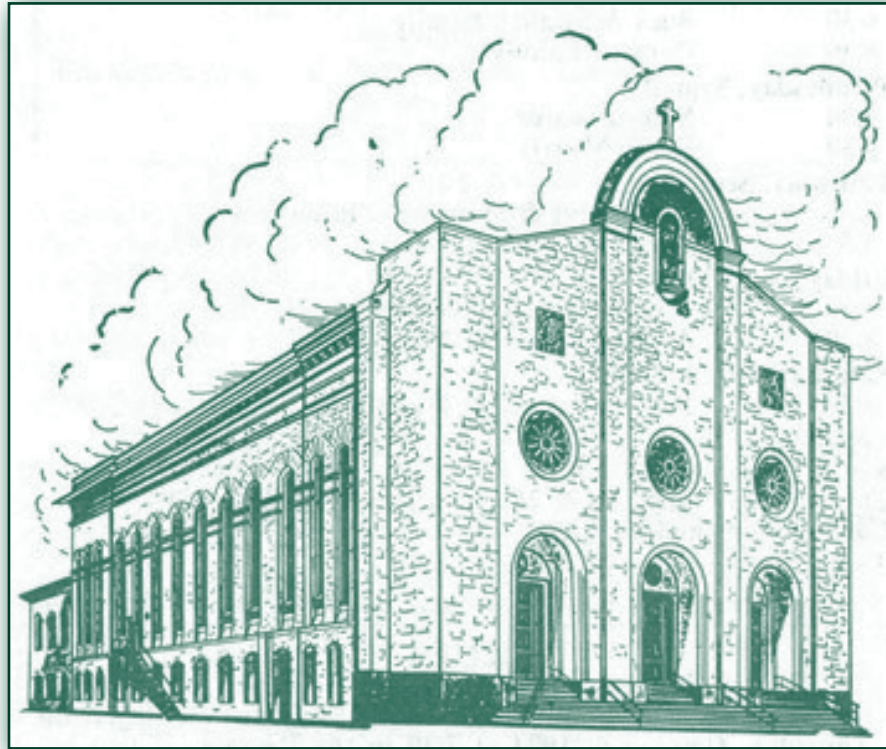

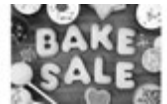

## Looking Back...

With the rush of immigrants coming into Philadelphia during the 1840's and into the 1850's, Bishop ( now Saint ) John Neumann gathered all of the pastors of the Philadelphia Diocese to a meeting on April 28, 1852 to encourage them each to devise ways and means of establishing a school in each parish.

Having liquidated much of the debt incurred by the founding of the parish in 1845 and the building of the church, Father Hugh McLaughlin, St. Anne's first pastor, decided that the parish was now financially able to "build, equip and maintain its own parochial school". With the support of the parishioners of St. Anne's, the work was begun, and on July 1, 1854 the cornerstone of the first St. Anne school building was laid.

A year later the building was completed. It was built next to the first rectory on Tucker Street, which later became part of the convent, alongside the cemetery at Memphis and Tucker Streets. It was a brick structure, eighty by forty feet, and three stories high. It was considered one of the largest and best equipped in the city at that time and it cost ten thousand dollars. ( This building along with the original rectory and the extension to the school with another adjoining building on Tucker St. moving towards Cedar, later became the convent to house the Sister of St. Joseph ).

The first students were enrolled on September 1, 1855, and throughout the first year were taught by a staff of lay teachers. The following year, the Sisters of St. Joseph came to St. Anne's with Mother M. Stanislaus as Superior, and were given the care of the school. It was at this point when the original rectory on Tucker St. was given over to the Sisters for a convent. ( A parcel of land on the corner of Memphis and Lehigh had been acquired by this time and a wood-frame house was built as the pastoral residence, later replaced by the current brown stone building in 1894 -95 ).

After the arrival of the Sisters, a number of the lay teachers were retained to teach the boys, but these too were replaced with the coming of the Christian Brothers in 1859.

This school served a generation of St. Anne Parishioners until, because of overcrowding, Father Barry, in 1894, determined that a larger school would be needed to serve St. Anne's growing population.
