May God forgive them.

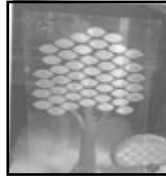


Saint Anne Guild Enrollment

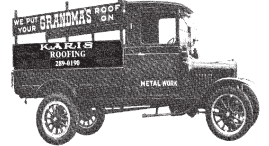
