Dear Friends,

Since the end of February of this year, the Archdiocese has been conducting the 2018 **CATHOLIC CHARITIES APPEAL**, the theme of which is **Giving Hope to All**. This year marks the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of this important annual appeal, and this milestone certainly allows us, as a local Church, to look back over these years with pride, realizing that, through the generosity of the faithful of the Archdiocese, literally millions of souls in need have been assisted, all in the name of Christ. The Catholic Charities Appeal reaches out to those among us with special needs, and the fact that the Archdiocese is the single largest provider of social services in the Delaware Valley is a testament to its far-reaching effects.

For the past several years, the Catholic Charities Appeal lasts for the extent of the calendar year (which means it actually won't be ending this year until the end of 2018). Many of you have already made a gift to this important annual appeal, and I thank you for your generosity. If you have not yet made a gift to the 2018 Appeal, I ask you to please prayerfully consider making a sacrificial gift to this very important campaign of the Archdiocese, which directly helps our ministries to those who are most poor and vulnerable. **World Mission Sunday: October 21, 2018 - SECOND COLLECTION NEXT WEEKEND**

World Mission Sunday is a day set aside for Catholics worldwide to recommit themselves to the Church's missionary activity through prayer and sacrifice. The theme this year is "Mercy Changes the World," and is a call to put faith in action. Our Holy Father, Pope Francis, reflects this call when he asks each one of us to "give voice to those not able to make their cries of pain and oppression heard." Your ongoing support of the Society for the Propagation of the Faith is vital to the missionaries serving in 1,111 dioceses throughout Asia, Africa, parts of Latin America and Europe, and on the Islands of the Pacific. The World Mission Sunday celebration highlights the outreach of local churches through priests, religious and laity among the poor and marginalized half a world away.
