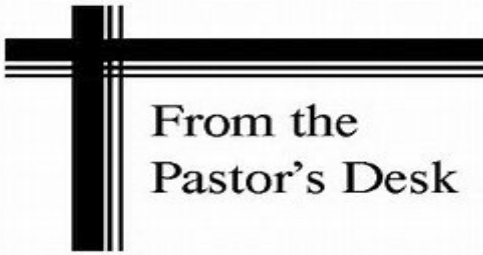

The historical context of the Old Testament reading puts Israel exiled in Babylon. As a result, they've hit rock bottom because they believe besides losing their property, wealth and their native land, they have also lost the love of God due to their sinful ways. But they are mistaken, for as our Gospel reminds us today, our thoughts are not God's thoughts. What we sometimes or even most of the times believe to be simple, rational and justified can be totally mistaken because God's plan can be incomprehensible. As such, even though the dejection of Israel makes them think that God can't

love them anymore Isaiah now assures them, if they turn back to God then He will be merciful. He will restore them.

Friends, let us never forget God's enduring mercy for all His children as proven by the cross of Jesus Christ who came to redeem us from our sinfulness. This act of love is truly mystifying and irrational for any individual but not for God. It is His way to remind us that even though we are sinners, He came to offer His love us in order to empower us to come back and reciprocate the love not just to Him but especially to impart such undying love to others as well.

Doubling up on the call for sharing the love, Archbishop Charles Chaput has asked us to be charitable once more in order to help the victims of Hurricane Irma and also the Diocese of St Thomas in the US Virgin Islands, under Bishop Bevard who is a Philly native, because of the devastation of their area. As such, we will have a second collection for the weekends of September 30 & October 1 plus October 7 & 8 respectively. Thank you again for your generosity during these successive calls for assistance.
