The Archdiocese of Philadelphia has announced that, effective June 19, 2017, Reverend Armand Garcia will be the Parochial Administrator Pro-tem of Saint Martin of Tours Parish.

On Sunday, June 11th at 2:00 P.M., we will be celebrating a special Mass in the upper church in thanksgiving for the years of service that the Sisters, Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary have given to Saint Martin of Tours Parish. As you know, Sister Ellen Giardino and Sister Agnes Andrew Logan will remain at Saint Martin Independence Mission School after this year, but the other sisters who are missioned at Saint Martin's will be missioned elsewhere, and Saint Martin's Convent will close. Our liturgy, then, on June 11th will be bittersweet, as we bid farewell to the strong IHM presence we have enjoyed for decades, but at the same time give thanks to God for the IHM community and the hundreds of sisters who have shared their charism with us all these years. Please mark your calendars to join us on June 11th at 2:00.

You need to know that there will be many IHM sisters present for the liturgy on June 11th, including many of the sisters who taught here as well as sisters who claim Saint Martin's as their home parish. This will be a great opportunity for you to greet sisters who taught you or your children, and to thank the sisters personally for all they've done for you and for our parish. After the liturgy, there will be a reception in the gym, with light refreshments, and it will be at the reception that you will have the opportunity to see and greet the sisters.

If you are planning to attend the June 11th Mass and reception, I would ask you to please call Kathleen Coleman at the rectory, to inform her of the number of people who will be attending. We want to be sure that we prepare for the reception adequately. I would ask that you RSVP to Kathleen as soon as possible, but no later than May 30th.

On Tuesday, May 23 2017, our parish welcomed Bishop Deliman who conferred the Sacrament of Confirmation on sixty students of our parish religious education program and SMT IMS. We congratulate these students, their families, sponsors and teachers! May the blessings and gifts of the Holy Spirit guide and strengthen them as they continue their faith journey as young adults in our parish!
