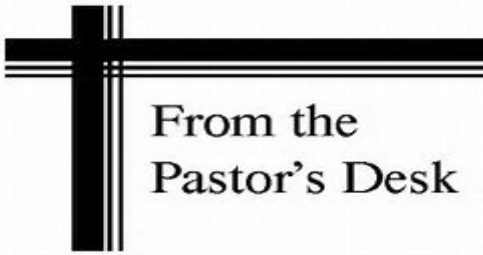

*Psalm 128*



One of the 5 major discourses of Jesus written in Matthew is about Eschatology: The end times when the Son of Man comes to judge and the fullness of the kingdom arrives. In light of this, He tells of the parable when the Master leaves his servants to make use of the money entrusted. There was no specific order because he hopes they know that they just have to follow his example on how he was successful.

In our case, we have God's everlasting love as example in the very person of the Savior Son who showed us the way which we should follow. How we have inherent talents bestowed in baptism as children of God who are configured to our Lord and empowered by the Holy Spirit to do good things. Some are capable of more others less, but the fact is that we all have the capacity to be like Jesus Christ.

Therefore, the challenge is for us to be faithful and wise just as the book of Wisdom portrays the image of the ideal wife plus how ST Paul cautions the people of Thessalonica to be vigilant for the coming of the Lord. Last but not least, our Psalm even points this out when we repeat the need to fear the Lord not because of God's wrath but more so, the thought of being separated from Him eternally if we do not follow Him.

Thank you again to all who helped out with the 40 hours celebration and Heritage Mass. May God continue to bless us with generous people willing to serve.
