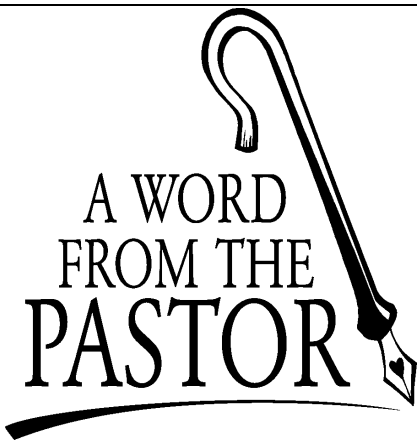
PARISH NEWS

As you know, next Sunday, October 21, is the opening of the **Forty Hours Devotion** in our Parish. We are justly proud of our excellent attendance as these beautiful Devotions, but as we all know, we have to always work to maintain what we have! We know how easy it is to let things fall by the wayside and, before we know it, they are lost. Please consider these words you are reading as a **PERSONAL INVITATION: NOT FROM THE PASTOR, BUT FROM OUR LORD HIMSELF**. It is He Who is either honored by your presence or disappointed by your absence.

How many challenges we all face in today's world! We are completely helpless in the face of them if we do not ask for the help of Our Lord. We all know that when we want someone's help the best thing we can do is to go to them in person. This makes it easier for us to explain our needs and yes, makes it a bit more difficult for the other person to refuse us! This is what we do when we come before Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament: we actually come into His Presence with all our petitions and our gratitude.

Please remember that this weekend is the time to make your plan for next week. Don't let anything interfere with your presence next Sunday, Monday and Tuesday evenings. We are doing all we can to prepare for these great days. The Church will be sparkling and beautiful, the Choir is practicing and Father Check is preparing his sermons! Now it is all up to you.

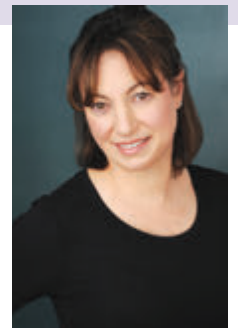
