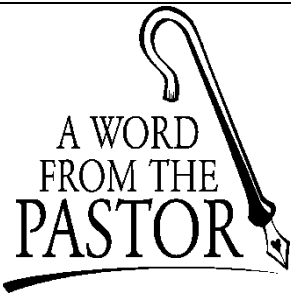

As you know, Sunday, October 15, is the opening of our Forty Hours Devotion. The Forty Hours Devotion is a great time of grace for a Parish, families and individuals. You know the great emphasis I place upon the Forty Hours Devotion here at Holy Saviour and I know your wonderful response in the past. I BEG OF YOU TO KEEP IT UP, AND EVEN IMPROVE UPON YOUR EXCELLENT ATTENDANCE IN THE PAST.

Remember that NOW is the time to be sure that you are free next Sunday, Monday and Tuesday evenings to make the Forty Hours. Some discount Sunday evening because you have already been to Church: NO, this is not the case, even though each evening is complete in itself and it is better to come one or two evenings than not at all, to receive the full benefit of the Forty Hours, it's best to give Our Lord all three evenings.

More than ever, when so many deny the Real Presence or act as if this Great Sacrament is just a piece of bread, or receive it sacrilegiously or without devotion, we need to manifest our Faith. God has been very good to so many of you and to this Parish as a whole; we need to thank Him in return.

We have been doing our part to prepare everything for Our Lord and for you, our devoted people, so that everything will be beautiful for the Forty Hours. We have a fine young priest who will be preaching the Forty Hours. Now, Our Lord looks to you for your response

Here is a little plan: Try to come to the 11:30 AM opening Mass of the Forty Hours on Sunday, October 16: Make a visit each day while Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament is exposed upon the Altar and, MOST OF ALL, be here all three evenings for the Devotions. All is being prepared, now Our Lord is waiting for YOU!

Flu Shots After Mass

Our own Angela D'Alessandro, a pharmacist at Giant, will again be available to provide flu shots to parishioners over age nine with insurance. She will be in the vestibule of the church on Sunday, October 8, after 7:30AM mass, before and after 9:30AM mass, and before and after 11:30AM mass. Medicare part B covers the cost of the flu shot, as do most insurances, so there is no expense to you. It will take only a couple of minutes to complete a brief consent form, show your Medicare (or insurance) card, and receive your flu shot. Official Surveys from Medicare

The Medicare Current Beneficiary Survey (MCBS) will soon take place in Pennsylvania. The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) will use the surveys to gather information on beneficiary out-of-pocket expenses as well as overall experience and use of Medicare benefits. The initial outreach will be by mail, and then by telephone to schedule an appointment to be interviewed. If you receive such contact and are uncertain if it is legitimate, you may call (800) MEDICARE to make sure this is not fraudulent, or you may contact Jennifer at (610) 270-2821 or jrose@chs-adphila.org if you would like assistance.

Medicare Annual Open Enrollment

The annual open enrollment for Medicare Advantage Plans and Prescription Drug Plans is from October 15 through December 7. 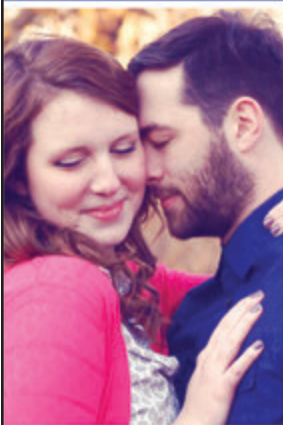

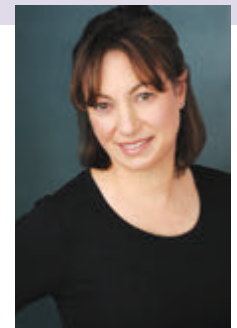
