PARISH REGISTRATION:

BAPTISMS:

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY:

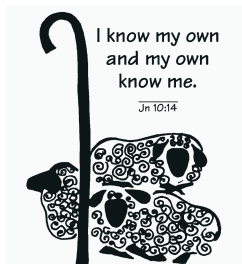

 from the supermarket.**

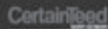
Flame of Love Easter Retreat
