PARISH REGISTRATION:

Please register after Mass on Sunday or during the week at the Parish Center. Please notify us if you are moving from the parish, or if your address or phone number has changed.

BAPTISMS:

The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Arrangements should be made at the Rectory or Parish Center during the month prior to the Baptism. Godparents need a letter of eligibility from their pastor. Instructions for parents are given in the week preceding.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY:

Couples planning marriage should contact the parish priest at their earliest convenience, but no less than six months prior to the intended date. Participation in a Marriage Preparation Program is required.

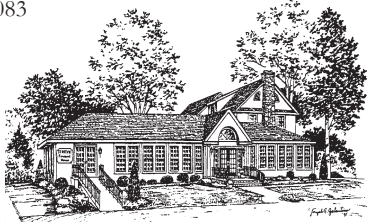
