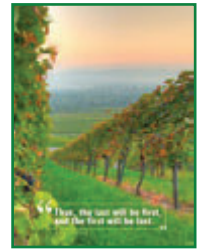

**BACKGROUND CHECKS AND TRAINING FOR VOLUNTEERS:** Archdiocesan policy requires all adult volunteers (unpaid) who may have any possible contact with or responsibility for children must obtain clearances, and renew every **five** years - PA State Police Criminal Background Check, PA Dept. of Public Welfare Child Abuse History Clearance, & FBI Fingerprint Clearance, as required by Pennsylvania law. ALSO, the Archdiocesan Policy requires that volunteers who have regular contact with children (at least one time per week) are required to complete parts one and two of the Safe Environment training within 90 days of beginning their volunteer work. **Part I: Protecting God's Children** (instructor-led), is offered regularly at sites throughout the Archdiocese. The training provides basic facts about child sexual abuse and adults' roles in prevention. Register at <https://www.virtusonline.org>. **Part II: The Mandatory Reporting of Suspected Child Abuse** (online) is available in English and Spanish. This training provides an overview of Archdiocesan reporting procedures for suspected child abuse and Pennsylvania Child Welfare Laws. The training should take you approximately one hour to complete. Volunteers who completed the training prior to November 2014 must sign the new policy acknowledgment form. My dear parishioners,

In any in-depth study of American history, few courses can be more numbing than constitutional history. Like it or not how we interpret the Constitution says as much about us and our agenda as it does about the origins and evolution of the basic framework of American government. Those who put together the Constitution were profound students of law, especially regarding the relationship between government and the governed. Our legal system began as an outgrowth of English Common Law and was gradually adapted to conditions here in the New World. By the time the Constitution was written, many American leaders had a good idea of where they thought we should go or not go. They were not shy about letting their opinions be heard and there was a vigorous exchange of ideas prior to the adoption of our present Constitution.

The "constitution" of Judaism at the time of Jesus was the Torah, the bedrock of which was the Pentateuch, the first five books of the Bible. Jesus was not shy about entering into the debate and with a difference. He openly contradicted what He held to be an erroneous interpretation and followed with His take on the Torah. Our present day journalists would term this a "robust" debate, one that challenged both Pharisees and Sadducees. The former were quick to take exception because Jesus pointed out that self-interest, not the common good, governed the Pharisees' take on the Law. They found it most profitable to take the lead in interpretation because ultimately they became the arbiters in legal wrangling and bent this to their benefit.

Matthew sets out six cases where Jesus as teacher and commentator on law deals with issues that are somewhat commonplace. The first is anger, which at first glance seems hardly worth arguing over. Anger, though, can and often does lead to a steady escalation in a disagreement and can result in an over-reaction. One need not look to ancient examples in the Middle East but some current ones where each side enlists justifiable anger as a motivating factor to the point where reason is not a factor.

Jesus' admonition should not be taken out of context. There are cases where denying anger by suppressing it can lead to some emotional problems. When we own anger and confront it, we can step back and discover why we were angry and what steps could be taken against acting out. Giving in to anger has fueled many a personal feud because there is no going back. Finding out why we were angry is frequently the first step to attaining self-control. We are all too aware of religious anger spilling over into acts of terrorism because a group was upset and decided to take it out on innocent bystanders. Watching people who feel aggrieved lose control and say things that they later regret is a painful experience. Undoing the damage can be an impossible task.

The second case may today be considered not worth worrying about. That nothing happened to follow through with the thought does not make it any less dangerous. The issue was adultery and given the volatile nature of this, simply thinking about it is quite simply a bad idea. In our time we have thrown aside a bundle of constraints and justify these by arguing that repression is bad. In fact, when it comes to family, marriage, and children, self-discipline is good. There is a higher goal that enables us to see the larger picture and to reflect that if the reverse were true, we would be hurt at the betrayal. Jesus' warning comes down to the fact that once we cast aside restraints in this area, the damage done is incalculable. (190)
