

**BAPTISMS**

Parents **must** register beforehand for the Baptism and Pre-Jordan class by contacting the Parish secretary. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sundays of the month at 1:00 p.m. Pre-Jordan classes are held in the rectory in the **Thomas Room** on the **second Wednesday** of February, April, June, August, October and December, from 7:30-9:00 p.m. Parents **must** attend Pre-Jordan prior to the Baptism. All godparents **must** be able to get a Letter of Eligibility from their parish where they are registered due one week **before** the Baptism. **Note:** A \$50.00 contribution is requested on or before the day of Baptism; \$25.00 if class is not required since class has been attended within last 5 years.

**SPONSORSHIP**

Any member of the parish who wishes to be a sponsor or godparent must be a practicing registered member of the parish and must meet the requirements for a Letter of Eligibility.

**PARISH MEMBER**

A parishioner is one who belongs to the parish family. As such, he/she is formally registered in the parish and is committed to St. Gabriel's through participation in the life of the parish community: spiritually, socially and financially.

**REGISTRATION FOR NEW FAMILIES**

New families that have recently moved into the parish can register at the Parish rectory Mondays-Thursdays 9 a.m. - 3 p.m., Fridays 9 a.m. - 2 p.m. or by appointment.

**SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY**

Consult the rectory early. Registration must occur at least six months prior to wedding date. Pre-marital instructions (Pre-Cana) are necessary. No weddings can be held in the Church on Saturday after 2:00 p.m.

**SACRAMENT OF THE SICK**

Please call and arrange anointing with the priest at the rectory. Please notify the Parish rectory when a neighbor, friend or relative is sick, hospitalized, or unable to attend Mass. The sacraments of Penance, Eucharist, or Anointing are our joy and privilege to administer.

**(Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults)**  
RCIA takes place on Tuesday evenings at 7:00 pm in the Rectory from mid-September through May. All are welcome, but it **is especially designed for adults** (and mature teens) **who are not baptized**. We heartily encourage those who have not completed First Holy Communion and/or Confirmation...and adults who are considering converting from a Protestant faith...to join us!. 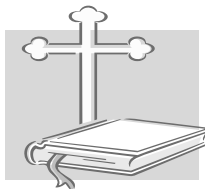

### FAST AND ABSTINENCE AND OTHER ACTS OF PENANCE FOR LENT 2018

The Bishops of the United States prescribe, as minimal obligation, that all persons who are 14 years of age or older are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, on all the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday. All persons 18 years of age and older, up to and including their 59th birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, while the other two meals on those days are to be light. All the faithful are encouraged, when possible, to participate at Mass and to receive the Holy Eucharist daily, to celebrate frequently the Sacrament of Penance, to undertake spiritual reading, especially the study of the Sacred Scriptures, and to participate in parish Lenten devotions, as well as Lenten education programs.
