SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM POLICY

Baptisms take place every Sunday in our church. Parents will need to call the rectory who will provide the phone number of who to call to schedule an interview (interview can be a phone call). Parents and Godparents attend one class before the child's Baptism. An Information Form needs to be filled out by the parent and a Declaration Form filled out by the Godparents. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, need to be a parishioner or will need a letter of good standing from his/her current Parish. *The choice of a Godparent should be made primarily on a spiritual basis.* Anyone requesting a baptism must be registered in the church (fill out our Census form) in order to get envelopes and must be actively attending Church each week.
