## **My dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,**

Jesus says to the Canaanite (non-Jewish) woman who approached him with a great faith for the healing of her demon- possessed daughter: "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish." St. Matthew, the evangelist testifies that the woman's daughter was healed from that hour (Mt 15:28).

This Scripture passage deals with the universal call to salvation. It hints that Christ's Church is Catholic that is, universal. We proudly call our Church and ourselves "Catholic". But, we seldom reflect on the meaning of that word. The church is Catholic does not mean that it exists all over the world but it signifies that the Church belongs to all classes of people.

But, we understand the term "Catholic" in another way today. In so many ways, our Church tends to be an elite church and a masculine church. Often women, Blacks, Hispanics and Orientals are seen as second- class members of the Catholic Church. It is a grave scandal and a contradiction to the teachings of Christ. For in the Church of Christ all people are equal, welcome and called to salvation. We all must learn to be *Catholic*.

## **Healing Mass with the glove of Padre Pio**

Our Parish will hold a Healing Mass, celebrated by Fr. Pio Mandato, a Franciscan Friar on Friday, September 22<sup>nd</sup> at 7.00pm. Fr. Pio Mandato, who is a distant cousin of Saint Padre Pio, will also bring a glove of Saint Padre Pio which he wore while he was experiencing stigmata. All are welcome.

## **Below is a brief biography of Padre Pio Mandato. Fr. Pio Mandato**

Fr. Pio Mandato FMHJ is a Franciscan priest living as a missionary hermit in the Diocese of Scranton PA. under Bishop Joseph C. Bambera, D.D.. Fr. Pio was born in Italy, his parents came from Pietrelcina in Southern Italy, the same town that Saint Pio, the famous stigmatist priest was from and they knew Padre Pio well. Fr. Pio received his first holy communion from Padre Pio before coming to the USA. He grew up in New Jersey and entered the Capuchin Franciscans at the age of 17, where he received his Franciscan formation and later priestly formation.

He was ordained in 1985 as a Capuchin and has been involved in various apostolates throughout the years, from hospital chaplaincy to working with the homeless in N.Y. and to giving retreats and doing healing masses.

In 1998 he was accepted into the Diocese of Scranton and began living a life of prayer as a hermit in solitude and at times going forth to preach. He is also the Chaplain of the Capuchin Sisters of Nazareth whose motherhouse is in Tunkhannock PA.

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas en el Señor,

Jesús le dice a la mujer cananea (no judía) que se le acercó con una gran fe para la curación de su hija poseída por los demonios: "¡Oh mujer, grande es tu fe, que se haga por ti como quieras". San Mateo, el evangelista testifica que la hija de la mujer fue sanada de esa hora (Mt 15:28).

Este pasaje de la Escritura trata del llamado universal a la salvación. Insinúa que la Iglesia de Cristo es católica que es universal. Orgullosamente llamamos a nuestra Iglesia ya nosotros mismos "católicos". Pero, rara vez reflexionamos sobre el significado de esa palabra.

La iglesia es católica no significa que exista en todo el mundo, sino que significa que la Iglesia pertenece a todas las clases de personas.

Pero, entendemos el término "católico" de otra manera hoy.

De muchas maneras, nuestra Iglesia tiende a ser una iglesia de élite y una iglesia masculina.

A menudo las mujeres, los negros, los hispanos y los orientales son vistos como miembros de segunda clase de esta Iglesia Católica. Es un grave escándalo y una contradicción con las enseñanzas de Cristo. Porque en la Iglesia de Cristo todas las personas son iguales, bienvenidas y llamadas a la salvación. Todos debemos aprender a ser católicos.

Fr. Pio Mandato FMHJ es un sacerdote franciscano que vive como ermitaño misionero en la Diócesis de Scranton PA. Bajo el obispo Joseph C. Bambara, D.D. Pio nació en Italia, sus padres vinieron de Pietrelcina en el sur de Italia, la misma ciudad que Saint Pio, el famoso sacerdote estigmatizó era de y conocían bien al Padre Pio. Fr. Pio recibió su primera comunión santa del Padre Pío antes de venir a los Estados Unidos. Creció en Nueva Jersey y entró a los franciscanos capuchinos a la edad de 17 años, donde recibió su formación franciscana y posterior formación sacerdotal.

Fue ordenado en 1985 como Capuchino y ha estado involucrado en diversos apostolados a lo largo de los años, desde la capellanía de los hospitales hasta el trabajo con los desamparados en N.Y. y para dar retiros y hacer misas curativa.

En 1998 fue aceptado en la diócesis de Scranton y comenzó a vivir una vida de oración como un ermitaño en la soledad y, a veces, salir a predicar. También es el Capellán de las Hermanas Capuchinas de Nazareth cuya casa matriz está en Tunkhannock PA.
