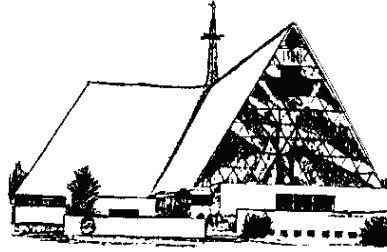

**The Conversion of St. Paul the Apostle  
Feast Day January 25th**




A turning point in the history of the early church was the conversion of St. Paul. Incidents are found in the Acts of the Apostles. It was a cause for celebration that a persecutor became a follower of Christ and later a teacher of the nations. May we imitate Paul’s willingness to be completely changed by encountering the risen Christ.

This is the first of three accounts of Paul’s conversion with some differences of detail owing to Luke’s use of different sources. Paul’s experience was not visionary but was precipitated by the appearance of Jesus, as he insists in 1 Cor 15:8. The words of Jesus, “Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?” related by Luke with no variation in all three accounts, exerted a profound and lasting influence on the thought of Paul. Under the influence of this experience he gradually developed his understanding of justification by faith (see the letters to the Galatians and Romans) and of the identification of the Christian community with Jesus Christ (see 1 Cor 12:27).

That Luke would narrate this conversion three times is testimony to the importance he attaches to it.

This first account occurs when the word is first spread to the Gentiles. At this point, the conversion of the hero of the Gentile mission is recounted. The emphasis in the account is on Paul as a divinely chosen instrument (Acts 9:15).
