Saint Rita of Cascia

Feast Day - May 22nd

The Gift of Thorn - At the age of thirty-six Rita pledged to follow the ancient Rule of Saint Augustine. For the next forty years she gave herself wholeheartedly to prayer and works of charity, striving especially to preserve peace and harmony among the citizens of Cascia. With a pure love she wanted more and more to be intimately joined to the redemptive suffering of Jesus, and this desire of hers was satisfied in an extraordinary way. One day when she was about sixty years of age, she was meditating before an image of Christ crucified, as she was long accustomed to doing. Suddenly a small wound appeared on her forehead, as though a thorn from the crown that encircled Christ's head had loosed itself and penetrated her own flesh. For the next fifteen years she bore this external sign of stigmatization and union with the Lord. In spite of the pain she constantly experienced, she offered herself courageously for the physical and spiritual well being of others. During the last four years of her life Rita was confined to bed and was able to eat so little that she was practically sustained on the Eucharist alone. She was, nevertheless, an inspiration to her sisters in religion and to all who came to visit her, by her patience and joyful disposition despite her great suffering.

Prayer is like a garden. Tend it and it will be fruitful.



Please notify the Bulletin Coordinators of any parish events you wish to have advertised or reported. Announcements must be in writing and at the Rectory by Noon, Friday, nine (9) days prior to publication.

Take a moment - ponder these words of Pope Francis:

- “We must all ask ourselves: how do I let myself be guided by the Holy Spirit in such a way that my life and my witness of faith is both unity and communion? Do I convey the word of reconciliation and of love, which is the Gospel, to the milieu in which I live. At times it seems that we are repeating today what happened at Babel: division, the incapacity to understand one another, rivalry, envy, egoism. What do I do with my life? Do I create unity around me? Or do I cause division, by gossip, criticism or envy? What do I do? Let us think about this.
- Spreading the Gospel means that we are the first to proclaim and live the reconciliation, forgiveness, peace, unity and love, which the Holy Spirit gives us. Let us remember Jesus’ words: “by this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another” (Jn 13: 34-35).
- A second element is the day of Pentecost. Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit and standing “with the eleven”, “lifted up his voice” (Acts 2:14) and “confidently” (v. 29), proclaimed the Good News of Jesus, who gave his life for our salvation and who God raised from the dead. This is another effect of the Holy Spirit’s action: the courage to proclaim the newness of the Gospel of Jesus to all, confidently... in a loud voice, in every time and in every place.
- Today too this happens for the Church and for each one of us: the fire of Pentecost, from the action of the Holy Spirit, releases an ever new energy for mission, new ways in which to proclaim the message of salvation, new courage for evangelizing. Let us never close ourselves to this action! Let us live the Gospel humbly and courageously!
- Let us witness to the newness, hope and joy that the Lord brings to life. Let us feel within us “the delightful and comforting joy of evangelizing” (Paul VI, Apostolic Exhortation, *Evangeliium Nuntiandi*, n, 80). Because evangelizing, proclaiming Jesus, gives us joy. Instead, egoism makes us bitter, sad, and depresses us. Evangelizing uplifts us.
- I will only mention a third element, which, however, is particularly important: a new evangelization, a Church which evangelizes, must always start with prayer, with asking, like the Apostles in the Upper Room, for the fire of the Holy Spirit. Only a faithful and intense relationship with God makes it possible to get out of our own closeness and proclaim the Gospel with a loud voice. Without prayer our acts are empty, and our proclamation has no soul -it is not inspired by the Spirit...Let us renew every day our trust in the Holy Spirit’s action, the trust that he acts within us, that he is within us, that he gives us apostolic zeal, peace and joy. Let us allow him to lead us. May we be men and women of prayer who witness to the Gospel with courage, becoming in our world instruments of unity and of communion with God. Thank you. (General Audience, May 22, 2013)

"Come Holy Spirit" Prayer

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit, and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth. Let us pray.

O, God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever enjoy His consolations. Through Christ Our Lord. Amen.

Come, Holy Spirit

The first request is to ask the Holy Spirit to come to you. You must believe there is a Holy Spirit and be willing and open to accept the spirit into your heart. This is the same Holy Spirit who Jesus told his disciples would be with them always after his crucifixion.

Fill the Hearts of Your Faithful

This part of the prayer is asking the Holy Spirit to fill you completely. This is a bold request. You are asking to be transformed by the Holy Spirit.

And Kindle Them the Fire of Your Love

The prayer now gets specific asking for the love that only the Holy Spirit can bring. The Holy Spirit's fire purifies the soul.

Send Forth Your Spirit and They Shall Be Created

You are asking the Spirit to make you a new creation. You are asking for a transforming renewal.

And You Shall Renew the Face of the Earth

When you are ignited by the Holy Spirit, you become part of the renewed world. Filled with the Holy Spirit, you can spread love and ignite other fires for spreading Christianity. You can become a source of renewal for all the people on the face of the earth.

O God, Who by the Light of the Holy Spirit

God is reaching out to you by way of the Holy Spirit.

Did Instruct the Hearts of the Faithful

The work of the Spirit is alive enlightening your heart as well as guiding and instructing you.

**Grant That by the Same Holy Spirit
We May Be Truly Wise**

The Holy Spirit is helping you to listen and discern. Being open to the Spirit enables you to move on to the next step.

And Ever Enjoy His Consolations

You conclude the prayer asking that this same Spirit to allow you to be truly wise. You give yourself up to enjoying or being consoled by what the Spirit gives you.

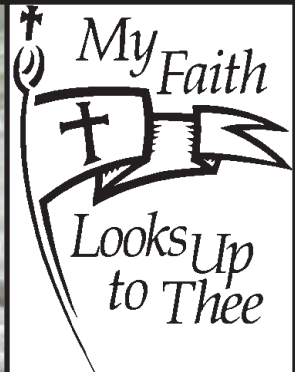
