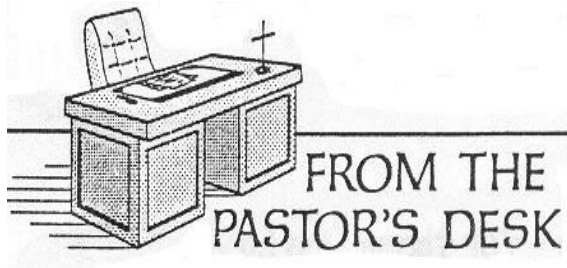

It is our fervent hope that through these gatherings, and other endeavors and gatherings, our parishioners will come to know one another a little better and so build up our Parish Community here at Saint Frances Cabrini.



ANNULMENT PROCESS

Realizing that over 250 couples within our Parish Community are currently in invalid marriages according to teachings of the Church, and recognizing the desire of many of these parishioners to validly receive Holy Communion at Mass, **I am pleased to once again offer my assistance to our parishioners.** As a first step, on behalf of our Metropolitan Tribunal, I am pleased to provide in today's Parish Bulletin, a simple, one page explanation of the procedure for investigating a Church Declaration of Nullity, that is, seeking a Church Annulment. Our parishioners will note that anyone can begin the process now from the ease of their own computer. If someone does not have access to a computer, they can call the Metropolitan Tribunal at 215-587-3750 so that they can receive the documents via the U.S mail.

As noted in the Special Insert, anyone who had a marriage that ended in divorce can petition the Metropolitan Tribunal for a Declaration of Nullity. The Tribunal would be looking to see if something was lacking in the intentions of the parties in regards to children, fidelity and permanence, and /or in their understanding of marriage, and/or in their ability to enter into and fulfill marriage.

As many of our parishioners know, for the past ten years I have been assisting parishioners regarding the annulment process, with the hope of obtaining a Decree of Nullity regarding their first marriage, so that they could enter into a second marriage which would be recognized by the Church. I am pleased to say that many parishioners have entered into the process with the result that the Decree of Nullity was granted on specific grounds and then had their marriage "blessed." Last year, there were more marriages being blessed than celebrated for the first time. Thus far this year, the trend is the same. More blessings of marriages are taking place than weddings.

I am personally pleased that the Holy Father, Pope Francis, had asked the bishops to consider waiving all costs and fees, and that Archbishop Chaput has done so. Over the years, so often, people have "put off" calling the Tribunal to begin the process out of concern for the cost involved which in recent years has been \$800. A second reason for not pursuing the annulment process has been with regard to the children born from the first marriage. **So often, former spouses think that by declaring their marriage as being annulled, it would render their children as illegitimate. This is not accurate. Since the marriage was recognized by the State, the children are absolutely legitimate. The Declaration of Nullity says that there was not a spiritual bond. Indeed, before the annulment process even begins, a divorce decree needs to be obtained.**

SCRIPTURE READINGS



TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Isaiah 55:6-9

Seek the Lord is Isaiah's invitation. The prophet even invites the scoundrel and wicked to turn to the Lord because Isaiah knows in the Lord is forgiveness so generous and so abundant that one will never turn back to one's old way of life. The Lord's thoughts as so infinitely high, like the heavens, that we find our hope for mercy in the Lord.

Second Reading: Philippians 1:20C-24,27A

Saint Paul established the first Christian community at Philippi and he now writes to them from prison. He understands the core of his faith to be life in Christ. Whether he lives or dies, he knows that he glorifies Christ in his body. His dilemma is that if he went on living, he could still serve the Philippians and continue the work of spreading the Gospel. If Paul were to die, he would be with Christ. In the midst of his own suffering, he exhorts the Philippians to behavior befitting those who proclaim the Gospel of Christ.

Gospel: Matthew 20:1-16A

Jesus tells His disciples the parable of the landowner and his workers. The landowner hires workers at varying times during the day, but pays them each the customary daily wage. Those laborers who worked more hours understandably exhibit frustration. The landowner's generosity turns the workers' worldview upside down. Such is the way it will be in Kingdom of heaven, where the last will be first and the first, last. This is God's new paradigm.

Parish Registration

Catholics living in the Parish boundaries should be registered in the Parish. Registration is required for the administration of the Sacraments, attendance at Holy Family Regional Catholic School or PREP, and for the issuance of Certificates of Eligibility for Baptism and Confirmation. Please call the rectory to make an appointment with Audrey Wilson, Director of Parish Services, in order to register in the Parish.

Baptism

Baptism is celebrated the first and third Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM. Please call the Rectory Office to make an appointment to meet with Audrey Wilson, Director of Parish Services, in order to register for the Sacrament of Baptism. Pre-Jordan classes, required for parents and godparents, are scheduled as needed in the church.

Godparents

Only one godparent is required for Baptism. If two are chosen, one must be male and one female. A godparent must be a fully-initiated Roman Catholic who is baptized, confirmed, and receiving the Eucharist, and must be at least sixteen years of age and in good standing with the Church, including marriage in the Church if they are married. A baptized non-Christian may be chosen as a "Christian Witness" provided there is one Catholic godparent. A former Catholic may not serve as either a godparent or Christian witness. Godparents will be asked to have their Parish complete a form witnessing to their eligibility to be a godparent.

For the Sacrament of Confirmation, the sponsor's eligibility requirements are the same as that of a godparent.

Sick or Homebound

Please contact the Rectory office to notify of a hospitalization, to receive the Sacrament of the Sick at home or to receive the Eucharist at home. If hospitalized, please notify the hospital that the patient is Catholic.

Marriage

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Please call the Rectory office for an appointment before setting the date of the wedding.

Moving

Please notify the Rectory office if you are moving.
