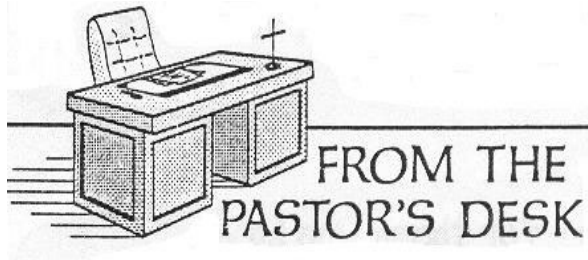

**RELIGIOUS LIBERTY**  
**FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**  
**(CONTINUED)**

In conjunction with the annual Fortnight for Freedom, which is sponsored by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, the Conference has provided a Fact sheet on Religious Liberty. Realizing that we are living in a society wherein our religious freedoms are constantly under attack, and that there is a need for our Catholic community to understand what is actually at risk not only for our Catholic community but also people of all faiths, it is our hope that our parishioners might come to a better understanding of religious liberty here in our Country. To this end, having begun on July 2<sup>nd</sup> and continuing for the next few weeks, we are pleased to provide the USCCB's *Frequently Asked Questions on Religious Liberty*.

**Historically, what significant religious liberty issues have affected Catholics in our country?**

**Equal treatment of Catholic Schools:** Catholicism was introduced to the English colonies with the founding of the Province of Maryland by settlers from England in 1634. However, the 1646 defeat of the Royalists in the English Civil War led to stringent laws against Catholic education and the extradition of known Jesuits from Maryland, as well as the destruction of the school they founded. During the greater part of the Maryland colonial period, Jesuits continued to conduct Catholic schools clandestinely. The American Revolution brought historic changes, and in 1782, Catholics in Philadelphia opened St. Mary's School, considered the first parochial school in the U.S. In 1791, the ratification of the Bill of Rights, with the First Amendment guarantee of religious freedom, helped Catholics further cement the establishment of Catholic schools.

Regardless, anti-Catholic sentiment in the late nineteenth century led to opposition to parochial schools. State governments opposed providing funds to aid students attending parochial schools, which Catholics founded largely in response to the requirement to pray and read from Protestant Bibles in public schools. Some Members of

Congress attempted to block all government aid to religiously affiliated schools with the proposed "Blaine Amendment" in 1875. This constitutional amendment was never ratified at the federal level, but many state legislatures adopted similar legislation and amendments. Those "little Blaine" amendments are still in place in the constitutions of about thirty-seven states, and still operate to block Catholic school students from equal participation in government educational benefits.

**Anti-Catholic bigotry in presidential campaigns:** During the 1884 presidential campaign, candidate James G. Blaine (who proposed the "Blaine Amendment" in Congress) attended a meeting in a church in New York at which a minister chided those who had left the Republican Party by stating, "We don't propose to leave our party and identify with the party whose antecedents are rum, Romanism, and rebellion." Blaine sat quietly during the anti-Catholic remark. The scene was reported widely in the press, and it cost Blaine in the election, particularly in New York City.

During the 1928 presidential campaign, Al Smith, a Catholic who had been elected governor of New York three times, was the Democratic candidate for president. It is widely believed that Smith's Catholic beliefs played a key role in his loss of the 1928 presidential election, as anti-Catholic sentiment among the electorate was strong. Many feared that Smith would answer to the pope and not the constitution if elected president.

During the 1960 presidential campaign, John F. Kennedy's Catholicism became a major issue in the election. Like Al Smith, Kennedy faced charges that he would "take orders from the Pope" and could not uphold the oath of office.

**Establishment of diplomatic relations with the Vatican:** In the first years of the United States, the new Republic had contacts with the Papal States. However, in 1867, Congress prohibited the financing of any diplomatic post to the Papal authority. This began a period of over seventy years when the U.S. did not have a diplomatic representative to the Pope, coinciding with a period of strong anti-Catholicism in the U.S. In 1940, President Roosevelt sent a "personal representative" to the Pope who served for ten years. However, when President Truman nominated an ambassador to the Vatican in 1951, opposition mounted, and President Truman abandoned the effort. Presidents Nixon and Carter sent personal representatives to the Vatican. In 1984, President Reagan announced that full diplomatic relations between the U.S. and the Vatican had been established, and the U.S. has continued to send ambassadors to the Vatican since then.

# SCRIPTURE READINGS



## FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### **First Reading: Isaiah 55:10-11**

In this passage from Isaiah, we hear that when the rain and snow fall to the earth it makes the plants and trees and all creatures live and grow. That is what God's Word is like: it is effective, making things grow and change in us, achieving what God wills.

### **Second Reading: Romans 8:18-23**

God does not care only for human beings, but for all of His creation and all of creation has a share in the redemption of the world through Christ. Through our Baptism, we are already God's children, set free from our slavery to sin, but we have received only "the first fruits," not the fulfillment of all God's promises. All of creation is waiting and we look to the time when not only ourselves, but the whole world will be redeemed.

### **Gospel: Matthew 13:1-23**

In this passage, we hear the familiar parable of the sower followed by Jesus' explanation of the parable to the disciples. The imagery and language of the parable is like veil, which both conceals and reveals the shape beneath. It is not enough to hear the Word, the seed. We must also be receptive to it, welcoming God's Word and seeking, understanding: when we do this, God opens our minds and grants us wisdom which makes us rich.

#### **Parish Registration**

Catholics living in the Parish boundaries should be registered in the Parish. Registration is required for the administration of the Sacraments, attendance at Holy Family Regional Catholic School or PREP, and for the issuance of Certificates of Eligibility for Baptism and Confirmation. Please call the rectory to make an appointment with Audrey Wilson, Director of Parish Services, in order to register in the Parish.

#### **Baptism**

Baptism is celebrated the first and third Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM. Please call the Rectory Office to make an appointment to meet with Audrey Wilson, Director of Parish Services, in order to register for the Sacrament of Baptism. Pre-Jordan classes, required for parents and godparents, are scheduled as needed in the church.

#### **Godparents**

Only one godparent is required for Baptism. If two are chosen, one must be male and one female. A godparent must be a fully-initiated Roman Catholic who is baptized, confirmed, and receiving the Eucharist, and must be at least sixteen years of age and in good standing with the Church, including marriage in the Church if they are married. A baptized non-Christian may be chosen as a “Christian Witness” provided there is one Catholic godparent. A former Catholic may not serve as either a godparent or Christian witness. Godparents will be asked to have their Parish complete a form witnessing to their eligibility to be a godparent.

For the Sacrament of Confirmation, the sponsor’s eligibility requirements are the same as that of a godparent.

#### **Sick or Homebound**

Please contact the Rectory office to notify of a hospitalization, to receive the Sacrament of the Sick at home or to receive the Eucharist at home. If hospitalized, please notify the hospital that the patient is Catholic.

#### **Marriage**

Arrangements must be made with the Pastor at least six months in advance. Please call the Rectory office for an appointment before setting the date of the wedding.

#### **Moving**

Please notify the Rectory office if you are moving.
