**MARRIAGE** - To adequately prepare to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage, Archdiocesan policy requires that couples contact one of the priests of the parish at least 6 months in advance.

IHM offers a one day **Pre-Cana** Seminar that assists couples in preparation for their upcoming marriage. The Pre-Cana is conducted twice a year (Spring and Fall). The **Spring** date is **to be determined**. Please call Denise Schmidt, parish secretary at 215-483-1000 to register for Pre-Cana.

**RCIA** - Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. This is the program for those interested in initiation into the Catholic Faith. Information is also available for those who may not have completed the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation). ### CHRISTIAN MEDITATION GROUP

Training in Christian Meditation and Contemplative Prayer

Fr. Andre will train and guide novices in meditation and contemplative prayer. He aims to start a Christian Meditation Group in the parish for those who wish to meditate daily on their own and weekly in a group.

**He will hold the Christian Meditation training on Saturday mornings from 9:00AM to 10:00AM in FSH. The first training session/group mediation will be on October 14<sup>th</sup>.**

**There are no fees but it requires your commitment to attend at least 8 continuous Saturday sessions and daily personal practice for 30 minutes**

Every now and then our Sunday scripture readings remind us more than usual of God's lavish and generous love. Today the gospel presents the parable of the generous landowner and workers in the vineyard. The latecomers get paid as much as those who worked all day. Is this fair or unfair?

The Old Testament reading from Isaiah gives us a good introduction to the parable from Matthew. The ways and thoughts of God are above our own. "For my thoughts are not your thoughts nor are your ways my ways, says the Lord" God is gracious in his forgiving. He is generous in his healing. He is generous in his helping. In our life journey we are constantly called to try to orient our thoughts to the models and lessons we are given in the scriptures.

The Parable presented to us today from Matthew (20:1-16) was most likely addressed to his opponents who criticized him for preaching the good news of the Kingdom to tax collectors and sinners. This can be called the Parable of the Good Employer. The vineyard owner hires workmen at dawn for the usual daily wage. Other workmen are hired at various times during the day but their wages are not specified ("whatever is just"). In verse 8 the employer commands that the workers be paid in reverse order of their hiring and all receive the same wage. To the complaints of those who had worked all day the employer answers that he has been just in paying the agreed wage to them; they have no right to complain if he wants to be generous to others. God's own justice and generosity are used to explain why Jesus preached the kingdom to both the already pious and the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

This parable is reflective of the kind of thing that actually happened in first century Palestine. The grape harvest was very important to the whole culture. In the Holy Land, grapes ripen about this point in the fall. Then at the beginning of October rains come. If the grapes are not harvested before the rainy season, the harvest can be lost. It is a race against time.

In such a situation any worker was welcomed, even for an hour. The pay was not great even for the full day. The workers in this story were not bums, just hanging around the marketplace. The market place was the employment office for common laborers. A worker would come there first thing in the morning and wait to be hired, sometimes all day. During grape harvest a landowner might go to the market place several times a day for additional help. At the end of the day, if he was a thoughtful person, the landowner might decide to give a days wage to these needy workers. And of course the reaction of those hired first: meanness, grumbling.

We focus today on God's great generosity and mercy to us sinners. We need to reflect on this and apply it to our lives. Saint Paul urges us in the second reading in the letter to the Philippians to "conduct ourselves in a way worthy of the gospel of Christ." As we listen to these sacred scriptures today, let us consider how we may reflect God's lavish love in our own lives. It is never too late to experience God's mercy and forgiveness. Let us pray in gratitude for our God whose generosity is so compelling and give thanks and share.

**SPONSOR GUIDELINES FOR BAPTISM/CONFIRMATION**

Church law requires that Baptism and Confirmation sponsors themselves frequent the sacraments regularly.

When someone who does not meet that requirement is designated as a sponsor, it is always an unpleasant (and frequently painful) experience for the priest, the parents of the child, and most especially for the person designated.

The reason a sponsor must be a practicing Catholic is that a sponsor is expected to pay special attention to the efforts of the person who is being baptized or confirmed to live a Christian life in keeping with the teachings of the Catholic Church. In the case of Baptism, sponsors are also expected to assist the parents of the child in their Christian duty as parents, by offering them support through good example, encouragement and prayer.

A sponsor should be a registered parishioner of IHM for at least 6 months. The person should also have received all the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation. The Sponsor must be at least 16 years of age. The Sponsor should also participate at Mass each Sunday. If married, the sponsor must also be in a valid Sacramental marriage.

By issuing a Sponsor Certificate, a priest assures members of the faithful that a person is a Catholic in good standing who is eligible to serve as a sponsor for Baptism and/or Confirmation.
