Dear Parishioners of Corpus Christi Church,

29 June 2017 marks my one-year anniversary as Pastor of this beloved parish in Mineola. I am so grateful to God for your welcome and acceptance of me as a priest in this your spiritual home.

With summer upon us all, I wanted to give you an update concerning the finances of the Church, especially in light of the 7 April 2017 sale of our convent and school building two. Originally, the Diocese of Rockville Centre and the Vatican in Rome, estimated the property value around \$5.7 million. Earlier this year, Mill Creek Residential offered us \$6.2 million. Corpus Christi counter-offered \$6.9 million. The sale price was settled at \$6.53 million. From this we paid out the following fees: \$26 thousand for NYS transfer tax; \$161 thousand in legal costs; \$261 thousand in real estate services. In addition, the parish for many years accrued a debt of \$307 thousand in loans owed to the Diocese, which we paid back in full. By paying back the principle, we terminated the finance charges, which were running our church more than \$2000 every month. We still owe the Diocese a staggering \$172 thousand in interest penalties over many years. We were able to negotiate that down to \$102 thousand, which we will be paying over the next three months. By the end of the Summer, Corpus Christi will be debt-free and financially strong, thanks be to God!

In the Fall, we will be having an open meeting for me as Pastor to listen to you all as parishioners, concerning the bright future of our church. For now, most of the proceeds from the sale will be safely invested, so that we can budget dividends and interest into the running of the parish. Right away now, we desperately need to repair the roof of our school building one, which will be costly. As a priest, I ask you all to continue your generous weekly sacrificial giving to Corpus Christi, as a sign of the strength of God's Kingdom growing in Mineola!

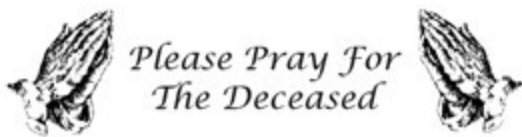

Espacio de la fe

Seguir a Jesús sin miedo es clave del éxito de la misión



En la primera lectura el profeta Jeremías viendo fracasar su misión, se siente rechazado por su pueblo y abandonado por todos y llega hasta dudar si su vocación no hubiera sido un error. En su desesperación grita al Señor todo su dolor, llega hasta maldecir el día de su nacimiento. Esta oración desesperada pero sincera hace emerger en él la certeza de la fidelidad de Dios y, lleno de confianza, proclama: «El Señor está conmigo como héroe poderoso y Él hará resplandecer la verdad y triunfar quien defendió la causa justa». La Iglesia necesita a muchos profetas que, como Jeremías, tengan el coraje de decir lo que el Señor les sugiere, incluso arriesgando la vida.

En la segunda lectura Pablo compara a Adán con Jesús: contrapone las consecuencias del pecado del primer hombre con la justificación operada por Cristo. La consecuencia del pecado de Adán fue la muerte. No la muerte biológica - que es un hecho natural - sino la «no vida» escogida por todos aquellos que se niegan a seguir el camino trazado por Dios. Sin embargo, la gracia obtenida por la obediencia de Cristo es muy superior a las desgracias provocadas por la insensatez humana. Por mérito de Cristo, Dios comunicó a todos los hombres su vida.

En el Evangelio de hoy, en tres ocasiones, Jesús insiste: «no tengáis miedo». Para quien tomó la decisión de seguir a Cristo, el miedo constituye muchas veces el peor enemigo, pues quien tiene miedo ya no es libre y nunca llega a donde debería llegar. Después de haber comprobado que está realmente siguiendo las indicaciones del Maestro, no debe dejarse tomar por el temor: es aquel el sentido justo, es él quien está conduciendo con los ojos abiertos y camina en la luz.

Espaço da fé **É PERIGOSO ANDAR EM CONTRAMÃO!**



Antes de embocar numa Estrada é preciso olhar para a sinalética, é necessário verificar se, por acaso, não nos estamos a aventurar num sentido proibido.

Quando observa o sentido em que se movem as outras pessoas, O discípulo de Cristo tem a sensação imediata e nítida de estar a conduzir em contra mão. Se escolhe o caminho da renúncia, da partilha dos bens, do amor desinteressado, do perdão sem limites da fidelidade à palavra, vê o tráfego mover-se no sentido oposto e dá-se conta que, mesmo que conduza com prudência, o embate é inevitável e será sempre ele a sofrer mais, a ser considerado deslocado, a ser acusado de quebrar as regras aceites por todos.

Na **primeira leitura** o profeta Jeremias vendo fracassar a sua missão, sente-se rejeitado pelo seu povo e abandonado por todos e chega até a duvidar se a sua vocação não teria sido um engano. No seu desespero grita ao Senhor toda a sua dor, chega até a amaldiçoar o dia do seu nascimento. Esta oração desesperada mas sincera faz emergir nele a certeza da fidelidade de Deus e, cheio de confiança, ele proclama: «O Senhor está comigo como herói poderoso e Ele fará resplandecer a verdade e triunfar quem defendeu a causa justa». A Igreja precisa de muitos profetas que como Jeremias, tenham a coragem de dizer aquilo que o Senhor lhes sugere, mesmo arriscando a vida.

Na **segunda leitura** Paulo compara Adão com Jesus: contrapõe as consequências do pecado do primeiro homem com a justificação operada por Cristo. A consequência do pecado de Adão foi a morte. Não a morte biológica – que é um facto natural – mas a «não vida» escolhida por todos aqueles que se recusam a seguir o caminho traçado por Deus. No entanto, a graça obtida pela obediência de Cristo é muito superior às desgraças provocadas pela insensatez humana. Por mérito de Cristo, Deus comunicou a todos os homens a sua vida.

No **Evangelho** de hoje, por três vezes, Jesus insiste: «não tenhais medo». Para quem tomou a decisão de seguir Cristo, o medo constitui muitas vezes o pior inimigo, pois quem tem medo já não é livre e nunca chega aonde deveria chegar. Depois de ter verificado que está realmente a seguir as indicações do Mestre, não deve deixar-se tomar pelo receio: é aquele o sentido justo, é ele quem está a conduzir com os olhos abertos e caminha na luz.

Neste Evangelho Jesus promete que reconhecerá diante de seu Pai aqueles que o tiveram reconhecido diante dos homens. Ele reconhece-se em quem não tem medo de anunciar o seu Evangelho, mesmo à custa da própria vida.
