

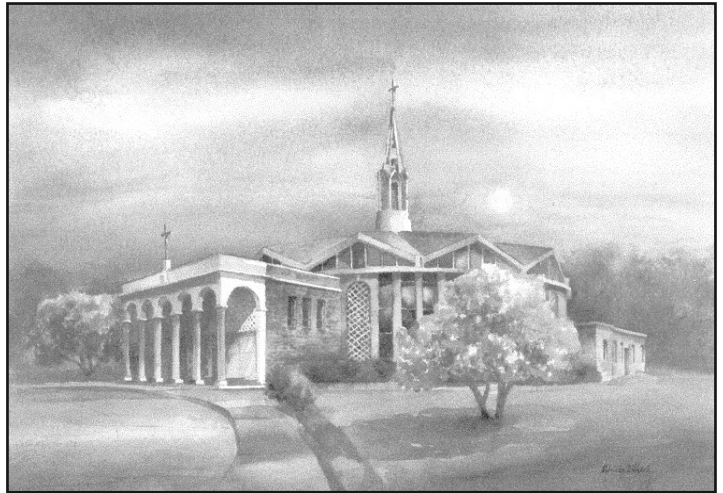

CELEBRATION OF SACRAMENTS

Reconciliation: The Sacrament of Penance takes place on Saturdays and on the day before First Fridays from 4:00 - 5:00 PM. At other times, the person should make the request directly to a priest.

Baptism: Baptisms are celebrated on the first and third Sunday of each month at 1:30 PM. To arrange a Baptism, please call the Rectory. A Baptismal Instructional session is required before the Baptism. Because Godparents play an important role in the child's Christian life and education, Godparents must be practicing Catholics who have been confirmed, are at least 14 years of age and, if married, must be in a marriage recognized by the Catholic Church. If there is a question about the suitability of someone to be Godparent, please call the Rectory before asking someone to be a Godparent.

Marriage: Engaged couples should contact the Rectory at least six months in advance. Diocesan regulations require a marriage preparation program for all couples.

Ministry to the Sick and Homebound: If a parishioner is in the hospital or homebound, please contact the Rectory. Arrangements can be made for the person to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Holy Communion can be brought to our homebound parishioners also.

PARISH MEMBERSHIP

We invite families and single adults who worship with us on Sundays to register officially as Sacred Heart Parishioners. Such registration helps when you are seeking a letter of eligibility for being a sponsor and for some marriage requirements. Registration takes place in the Rectory, usually weekdays. Moving? If moving outside the parish or inside the parish, please notify us of the change. All parishioners are encouraged to use the Sunday offering envelopes.

PREGNANCY AND ADOPTION SERVICES

The Catholic Guardian Society and Home Bureau Maternity Services (CGSHB) is a department within Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of New York. CGSHB provides free counseling to any client regardless of age, legal status, religion, race or economic status who is faced with concerns arising from an unintended pregnancy. Counseling is provided by professional social workers who schedule visits at a convenient location, either a local Catholic Charities Office, the client's home or at a site requested by the client. Staff offers on-going support and counseling, help in securing pre-natal care, referrals for housing, WIC, budgeting, limited financial assistance, maternity clothing, infant clothing-diapers-baby equipment, legal assistance (child support), infant care and parenting classes and discussion of all available parenting options. Staff seeks to involve the parents of minors and reach out to include the expectant fathers. They maintain a relationship with the client for approximately eight weeks following the infant's birth.

CGSHB is also a New York State authorized adoption agency and offers a full range of counseling/education/placement services to the birth mother or father and adoptive parents in addition to conducting home studies for international adoptions.
