2019 Sharing God's Blessings Annual Appeal

We Are Living Stones – If you have not filled out your pledge envelope for the Capital Campaign "We are Living Stones", my dear friends, I would like to encourage you to please do so as soon as possible. So far, the Archdiocese has received **\$168,114.51** of Pledges from **106** families or individuals from St. Leo's Church, and **\$97,723.60** in cash, with an average of **\$1,585.99** per family. We have **823*** families who are registered in the Parish. Our Parish Goal is **\$225,069**; which means that we have attained **74.69%** of our Goal. Remember my dear friends, that after the Works of Mercy (**\$20,000**), St. Leo's Church will receive 50% of all the money collected, and **60%** once we go over our Goal; that money will be used for Parish Building Repairs and General Maintenance. To date, our parish portion is **\$38,861.80**. 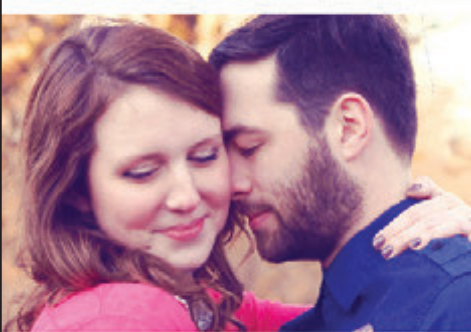
