Literature in Middle School



Middle school literature is more than just reading books. It's a journey of self-discovery, reflection, and growth that helps pre-teens and young teens navigate their ever-widening world. Our middle school literature teacher, Mrs. Lamb, has started some activities that will enable our 6th grade to begin this journey, encourage our 7th grade to dig deeper into themselves and inspire our 8th graders to take all they learned through high school and beyond.

The 6th grade started the year reading a story about being eleven, the age most students are in 6th grade. The students discussed how society has ideas of what children at certain ages are like, but each child does not always fit the mold. They then had to answer a writing prompt "Would you act differently to impress someone?"

Seventh grade is preparing to embark on a wonderful SBA tradition, reading "A Christmas Carol" by Charles Dickens. Through a series of cross-curricular projects, the students will immerse themselves in Victorian England learning about their history and culture.

Eighth grade has taken the skills they have refined over the past few years and become authors. They are working in groups writing short stories about conflict and resolution for their first-grade prayer buddies.
