Pastor's Message

Dear Parish Family,

The Easter message this weekend is "Peace". "Peace be with you," Jesus said when He appeared to His disciples on the evening of Easter Sunday. Whenever the Risen Lord appeared, His greeting was always: "Peace be with you. Do not be afraid." Actually, peace was Christ's message throughout His whole life. The prophet Isaiah called Him the "Prince of Peace". At the Last Supper, Jesus said, "I will give you the gift of my peace. It is not the kind of peace that the world gives you. It is my peace".

What kind of peace does Jesus offer? The peace of Christ is more than the absence of trouble. He does not mean a mere absence of war or noise. Rather, peace or shalom - the Jewish word, meant freedom from trouble. It meant health, it meant a secure and contented life. Jesus offers the peace which conquers our fears and anxieties. St. Augustine has a beautiful definition of peace. According to him, peace means "serenity of the mind, simplicity of the heart, tranquility of the soul".

The Holy Mass is a celebration of peace, a sign of peace, a source of peace, a treaty of peace. May every house and heart in the world hear the greeting of Christ. "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give to you". May Christ's peace always reign in your hearts.

This Monday, May 27th, is Memorial Day. It is an American holiday, observed on the last Monday of May, honoring the men and women who died while serving in the U.S. Military. We want to take this opportunity to thank all those who served in the military and risked their lives to protect our rights, freedom and liberty. On this Memorial Day, I encourage everyone to take some time out of their day to reflect and honor the heroism of the soldiers who have died for us in the past and all those who are currently serving for us. We salute, honor and thank you for shedding your blood for us.

On Thursday, May 30th, we celebrate The Ascension of the Lord. It is a Holy Day of Obligation whereby Catholics are obliged to attend Mass. We will celebrate the Ascension on Wednesday, May 29th at 7:00 p.m. (Vigil Mass) and on Thursday at the 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Masses.

May God continue to bless us and all parish endeavors.

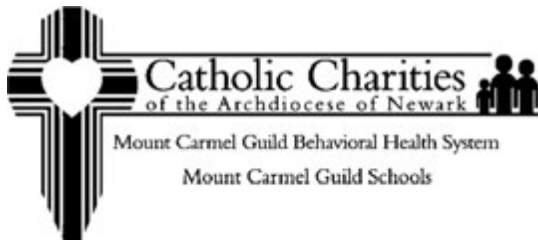
