A Message From Your Pastor

This Tuesday, November 21, I celebrate the 30th Anniversary of my Ordination to the Priesthood and I thank you for all of your support for me and all of our priests. I wanted to share a few thoughts with you on this occasion.

As my brother priests know so well, priesthood is not something we do, but someone we are. Priesthood is not a job- it is a vocation- it is a way of life. Despite my limitations and weaknesses, at the core of my being I am blessed to be a priest of Jesus Christ. I am filled with gratitude and joy. I am grateful to God for calling me to be one of His priests and for using me as one of His instruments in the world today. My joy comes from recognizing the privilege that it is to be part of people's lives in so many ways- to share with them their joys and their sorrows.

I recall the prayer card from my Ordination that said: "A priest is called to bring God to all people and all people to God." That is what I have tried to do over the past thirty years and with God's help, that is what I will do for many more years! I ask you to pray for all priests- that they may be faithful to their calling. I also ask you to pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

On another note, I hope that many of you will plan to join us for our annual Thanksgiving Day Mass at 9:00am. This is always a wonderful way to come together as a parish family to give thanks to the Lord for His many gifts and blessings. Don't forget to bring a bag of non-perishable food to be presented at the Offertory time at Mass! It is a beautiful visible sign of our concern for others when we see all of those bags of food gathered around the altar!
