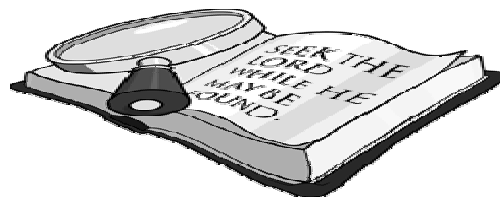
Try Something New This Summer at Seton Hall
