Reflections on Catechism

Summer Hunger Update from the Food Pantry

Summer is an especially difficult time for our food pantry patrons who have children at home. With school closed, children in need do not receive free/reduced-price lunches and breakfasts. Local summer feeding sites are few and far between, with none in South Orange or Maplewood. So many food pantries, including ours, step in to fill the summer hunger gap. We double up on efforts to collect shelf-stable milk (cow, almond, soy are all great), cereals, fruit, peanut butter, tuna and other nutritious (low-sugar, low-salt) child-friendly foods. These are the items highest on our wish list now--especially shelf-stable milk, thanks!

Book Pantry Update

You may have noticed that our food pantry recently added a children's book pantry alongside our food pantry. It has become very popular with many of our patrons, our parents, grandparents, and caregivers who select summer reading choices for their students with the help of Anne Quinn, our dedicated librarian. Thank you to everyone who has donated new or gently used books for reading levels thru 8th grade! One surprise is a request from our adult patrons for dictionaries, regular Merriam-Webster English versions and English-French as well, as we serve many Creole speakers. So, if you're tidying up your bookshelves this summer, we'd be happy to adopt your extra dictionaries. Just bring them to the little brown desk outside our pantry door, thanks!
