A Note from Our Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

You will recall that during the "We Are Living Stones" campaign a few years ago, all parishes in the archdiocese were asked to identify renovation projects that they would undertake with the funds generated. Our parish identified painting the interior of our worship space as one such project. The "ghosting" phenomenon has developed again through the years, whereby the gradual discoloring of the walls and ceilings does not take place evenly, but occurs more pronounced over the studs behind the sheet rock, creating well-formed lines across the surfaces. Cleaning procedures removed some of its heaviness, but the noticeable lines do remain. We also have had some water issues in a few spots that have been resolved, but not before peeling back the paint in some places. As we consider repainting in the foreseeable future, we developed two possible borders to add as trim around the window bays. Depending on the feelings of our people, we could incorporate this addition into the painting project as we continue to formulate our plans. I invite you to share your thoughts about the two possibilities that have been added as samples to two window bays in the back corner of the rectory side of the church. As you can see, one, which was displayed last year, has some ribbing around the top of the bays with plastering along the sides that replicates brownstone with which the outer walls of the building are constructed. It's quite similar to the bordering around some of the windows on the outside. The other possibility is a more simple ribbing that completely borders the window bays without any of the brownstone theme. Let me know your thoughts about which one you prefer. Or, if you think it might be preferable to leave the sides plain as they have been since the renovation of the church some years ago, then mention that as your recommendation. As always, you can speak to me before or after Mass or by contacting me at the Parish Center.

Let us always give thanks for our house of worship. In all that we do to beautify it, may we contemplate the glory of God and trust that what we create with the Lord's help will reflect that glory to all who share in the worship and prayer in this house of our community of faith.

The Apostles' Creed During Easter Time

Beginning on the Second Sunday of Easter and continuing through Pentecost, the Apostles' Creed will be used at Mass instead of the Nicene Creed.

The origins of the Apostles' Creed are believed to predate the Nicene Creed and is recognized by many Christians as a shared statement of our faith in God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

The Apostles' Creed may be used at any Sunday Mass, but the church recommends its use especially during (Lent and) Easter Time. Why? Because the words of this ancient Creed have been used for centuries as the basis of our baptismal promises, and the seasons of (Lent and) Easter put a strong focus on baptism. During Lent we prepare those who will be baptized at Easter while readying ourselves to renew our own baptismal promises. As we recite the Apostles' Creed, it will stir up in our hearts our commitment to Christ which was first made at our own baptism.

The Apostles' Creed is the basis for the baptismal promises made by the elect before they are baptized. It is also used for the renewal of baptismal promises at Easter and by parents and godparents when bringing a child for baptism.

Using the Apostles' Creed during the Easter Season is also an opportunity to familiarize ourselves with the new translation in the Roman Missal.

The Fifty-fifth World Day of Prayer for Vocations April 22, 2018

World Day of Prayer will be observed Sunday, April 22, also known as "Good Shepherd Sunday." The purpose of this day is to publically fulfill the Lord's instruction to, "Pray to the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest" (Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2). Please pray that young men and women hear and respond generously to the Lord's call to the priesthood, diaconate, religious life, societies of apostolic life or secular institutes.
