## A Note from Our Pastor

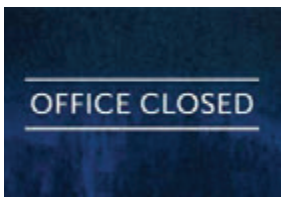
Dear Parishioners,
