## Scripture Reflection

**Matthew 13:1-23**

Jesus told the Parable of the Sower, in which the seed is the Word of God and the different kinds of soil in which it is planted will produce some rather different results.

He also told His disciples that He even though He teaches in parables, some will just not understand them because of the hardness of their hearts.

Of the four types of soil mentioned in the parable (path, rocky ground, among thorns, and rich soil) which one am I and why?

What do I make of the fact that in three of the four kinds of environments in which the seed is sown, it fails to produce good results? What is Jesus teaching me?

Jesus noted that many prophets and righteous people wanted to see what the Apostles see, namely Jesus Himself. How have I been blessed because the Apostles passed on what they learned from Jesus? because they told us of their experience of Him in the Gospels?
