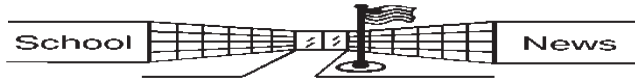

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION 2018-2019

Our Religious Education Program is being updated, with the guidance of the Archdiocese. We are moving to a *Family Faith Format*. Many churches across the country are using this format to engage families in discussion and the continued learning of our Catholic Faith.

What is changing: Online as well as textbook learning with Interactive Learning through Loyola Press for the entire family. Families (parent/s, grandparents, guardians, aunts/uncles or the adult in the family who can commit to these guidelines) will meet in the parish Center once a month for 7 months for a 2 hour meeting, and a weekly at home 1 hour program of study. Don't panic...Your family moderator will be available to guide and help you.

At our 2 hour monthly meeting: We will guide families in topics for discussion and introduce the theme for the rest of the month, then break up into peer groups and adult discussion. We will also share refreshments and occasional meals. At Home: Families will join together once a week, at their convenience and listen to or read a lesson; do age appropriate fun activities together and report back to your family moderator through an online link with your results. 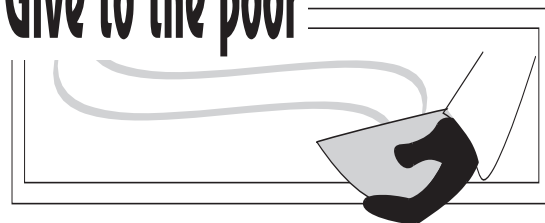
