REFLECTIONS FOR JULY 15, 2018

First Reading: Amos 7:12-15

In this biographical interlude between Amos' five visions, we find Amaziah, the priest of Bethel, speaking to Amos with contempt. Then Amos tells him that his prophetic work all came about through God's choice of him and not the other way round.

Second Reading: Ephesians 1:3-14, or 1:3-10

This whole section is a blessing composed by St. Paul. He cites being a blest person because God chose him for adoption. He also acknowledges that our forgiveness comes about from Christ's death on the cross.

Gospel: Mark 6:7-13

Mark presents the mission of the Twelve as an extension of Jesus' own ministry. Having no concern with extra baggage reflects the kind of trust in God that the mission involves. Nor were the Apostles to seek better accommodations than what were offered to them in their travels.

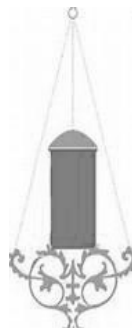




