REFLECTIONS FOR DECEMBER 17, 2017

First Reading: Isaiah 61:1-2a, 10-11

The opening verses here were read aloud by Jesus one day in the synagogue to announce Himself as the Messiah. It almost got Him killed. For the prophet it was his own inauguration. He rejoices in the union between Jerusalem and Yahweh.

Second Reading: I Thessalonians 5:16-24

This letter is the earliest written book in the New Testament. In it Paul gives a list of instructions for behavior, and also writes that joy is the fruit of the Spirit.

Gospel: John 1:6-8, 19-28

The passage describes John the Baptist's role. While he is not the messiah, he witnesses to him. John asserts his true role as **“a voice crying in the desert.”**

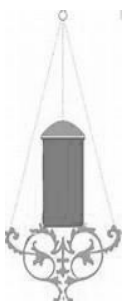
