OLF PREP REGISTRATION 2018-2019

This information is for new families who wish their child (ren) to attend the Parish Religious Education Program in Our Lady of Fatima Parish:

Classes are held on Tuesday afternoon: 4:15- 5:30 pm in OLF Lower School

Tuition: \$150 (1 child) \$200 (2 children)
\$250 (3 or more children)

Please have a copy of your child's baptismal certificate with you at the time of registration if your child was not baptized in Our Lady of Fatima Parish. Diocesan sacramental policies require a two year preparation for First Penance and First Holy Communion and again a two year preparation for the sacrament of Confirmation.

The PREP Office is located in the parish rectory and is open between the hours of 10:00 am and 4:00 pm each day.
