### PARISH REGISTRATION:

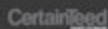

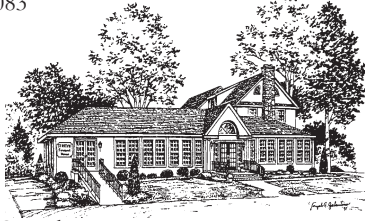
